john s millis in 1966 the citizens commission on graduate medical education observed that the explosive growth in biomedical science and the consequent increase in medical skill and technology of the twentieth century had made it possible for physicians to respond to the episodes of illness of patients with an ever increasing effectiveness but that the increase in knowledge and technology had forced most physicians to concentrate upon a disease entity an organ or organ system or a particular mode of diagnosis or therapy as a result there had been a growing lack of continuing and comprehensive patient care the commission expressed the opinion that now in order to bring medicine s enhanced diagnostic and therapeutic powers fully to the benefit of society it is necessary to have many physicians who can put medicine together again the commission proceeded to recommend the education and training of sub stantial

numbers of primary physicians who would by assuming primary responsibility for the patient's welfare in sickness and in health provide continuing and comprehensive health care to the citizens of the United States in 1978 it is clear that the recommendation has been accepted by the public the medical profession and medical education there has been a vigorous response in the development of family medicine and in the fields of internal medicine pediatrics and obstetrics one is particularly impressed by the wide acceptance on the part of medical students of the concept of the primary physician Dr John S
