the structure of the political party environment mattered and assesses the case studies through indicators of concordance and discordance finally the thesis looks at the presence of military entrepreneurship asserting that variance depends on military capacity to engage in external business activities and civilian willingness to allow such activities the thesis concludes by assessing the explanatory power of the three factors above and concluding that a combination of pre independence legacies and party structure best explains civil military relations in the region
