The novel was inspired by Robert Blincoe's account of his childhood spent in a cotton mill. *Oliver Twist* is an orphan who is born in a workhouse and later sold off into an apprenticeship. Dickens situates his protagonist amid the squalid lives of beggars, criminals, and petty thieves trapped in a world of corruption and poverty. Oliver, with his pure heart, is rewarded with a fairytale ending. The dark reality of child labour, the effects of industrialisation, and the condition of orphans in London in the mid-19th century form the crux of Dickens' heart-rending novel. *Great Expectations* revolves around the life of an orphan nicknamed Pip.
