how amateur programmers in 1980s czechoslovakia discovered games as a medium using them not only for entertainment but also as a means of self expression aside from the exceptional history of tetris very little is known about gaming culture behind the iron curtain but despite the scarcity of home computers and the absence of hardware and software markets czechoslovakia hosted a remarkably active diy microcomputer scene in the 1980s producing more than two hundred games that were by turns creative inventive and politically subversive in gaming the iron curtain jaroslav Ůvelch offers the first social history of gaming and game design in 1980s czechoslovakia and the first book length treatment of computer gaming in any country of the soviet bloc Ůvelch describes how amateur programmers in 1980s czechoslovakia discovered games as a medium using them not only for entertainment but also as a means of self expression sheltered in state supported computer clubs local programmers fashioned games into a medium of expression that unlike television or the press was neither regulated nor censored in the final years of communist rule czechoslovak programmers were among the first in the world to make activist games about current political events anticipating trends observed decades later in independent or experimental titles drawing from extensive interviews as well as political economic and social history gaming the iron curtain tells a compelling tale of gaming the system introducing us to individuals who used their ingenuity to be active be creative and be heard

arguing that british comics are distinct from their international counterparts a unique showcase of the major role they have played in the imaginative lives of british youth and some adults in this entertaining cultural history of british comic papers and magazines james chapman shows how comics were transformed in the early twentieth century from adult amusement to imaginative

reading matter for children beginning with the first british comic ally sloper known as a selection side splitting sentimental and serious for the benefit of old boys young boys odd boys generally and even girls british comics goes on to describe the heyday of comics in the 1950s and 60s when titles such as school friend and eagle sold a million copies a week chapman also analyzes the major genres including schoolgirl fantasies and sports and war stories for boys the development of a new breed of violent comics in the 1970s including the controversial action and 2000ad and the attempt by american publisher marvel to launch a new hero for the british market in the form of captain britain considering the work of important contemporary comic writers such as alan moore grant morrison ian edginton warren ellis and garth ennis chapman s history comes right up to the present and takes in adult oriented comics such as warrior crisis deadline and revolver and alternative comics such as viz through a look at the changing structure of the comic publishing industry and how comic publishers writers and artists have responded to the tastes of their consumers chapman ultimately argues that british comics are distinctive and different from american french and japanese comics an invaluable reference for all comic collectors and fans in britain and beyond british comics showcases the major role comics have played in the imaginative lives of readers young and old

time is one of the most prominent themes in the relatively young genre of children s literature for the young like adults want to know about the past this book explores how children s writers have treated the theme and concept of time the volume starts with the application of literary theory and additionally analyzes examples of the juvenile historical novel in doing so it also examines changing fashions in criticism and publishing and the pressure they exert on writers it then considers literary adaptations of myths and archetypes constructions of history in children s literature colonial and postcolonial children s fiction and the treatment of the past in the postmodern era the book looks at literature from around the world and the expert contributors are from diverse countries and backgrounds while the book looks primarily at literature of the 19th and 20th centuries it considers a broad range of historical material treated in works from that period included are discussions of such topics as joan of arc in children s literature the legacy of robinson crusoe colonial and postcolonial children s literature the holocaust and the supernatural international in scope the volume examines history and collective memory in portuguese children s fiction australian history in picture books norwegian children s literature and literary treatments of the great irish famine

this book presents a unique annotated collection of some 2000 playground games rhymes and wordplay of london children it charts continuity and development in childlore at a time of major social and cultural change and offers a detailed snapshot of changes in the traditions and language of young people topics include starting a game counting out rhymes games without songs singing and chanting games clapping skipping and ball bouncing games school rhymes and parodies teasing and taunting traditional belief and practice traditional wordplay and a concluding miscellany recorded mainly in the 1980s by primary schoolteacher nigel kelsey transcribed verbatim from the children s own words and accompanied by extensive commentaries and annotation the book sets a wealth of new information in the wider historical and contemporary context of existing studies in britain ireland and other parts of the english speaking world this valuable new resource will open new avenues forresearch and be of particular interest to folklorists and linguists as well as to those working across the full spectrum of social cultural and educational studies

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
