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no religious or mystical tradition is immune from the presence of spiritual abuse for wherever there are people who are seeking to become closer to essential truths purpose and meaning there will be individuals seeking to

generate counterfeit currency to offer to those who are unaware or incautious toward the dangers which lie in wait along the spiritual path fraudulent teachers might call themselves a guru shaykh rimpoché monk priest imam apostle avatar or minister they might also call themselves educators revolutionaries political leaders and freedom fighters whatever they might call themselves if they seek to gain control over others through techniques of undue influence then they are propagators of spiritual abuse this book is relevant to individuals from all spiritual traditions but often focuses on the sufi spiritual tradition

water has long been associated with the magical the mysterious and the divine from sacred springs to holy wells and from hydropathic cures and temperance reform to the modern spa ian bradley explores how water's creative health giving and restorative powers have been conceived worshipped and marketed in an essentially spiritual way in pre christian times springs and rivers were seen as the dwelling places of deities with magical life giving and curative powers associated especially with the feminine and with ritual cleansing and rebirth with the coming of christianity water was incorporated into christian ritual and tradition through baptism and the cult of holy wells from the 16th century onwards the benefits of water came to be seen more in terms of therapeutic healing than the miraculous through the development of drinking and bathing cures spas and hydrotherapy a more scientific but still essentially spiritual understanding of the curative properties of water was developed by the eighteenth century spas and watering places had acquired their own enchanted and mysterious qualities in many ways taking the place of medieval pilgrim shrines now a new more hedonistic kind of pilgrim comes to modern spas to experience a potent post modern elixir of self oriented well being

three issues of paramount importance namely fundamentalism spiritual abuse and terrorism are brought together in one volume in a way that delineates the interconnected dynamics of these topics moreover these central themes are engaged from a variety of perspectives ranging from on the one hand psychology sociology and philosophy to on the other hand history political science and religion the author draws upon more than forty five years of experience on the sufi path to lend a unique perspective to the manner in which terrorism fundamentalism and spiritual abuse are explored and analyzed throughout the book

with many authors coming from female indigenous and lgbtqia contexts combining established and emerging voices and practice led research and critical scholarship the book explores water across its scientific symbolic material imaginary practical and aesthetic dimensions it examines and interrogates our cultural construction and representation of water and through original research and theory suggests ways in which we can reframe the dialogue to create a better relationship with water sources in diverse contexts and geographies this expansive book brings together key emerging scholarship on water persona and agency and would be an ideal supplementary text for discussions on the blue humanities climate change environmental anthropology and environmental history

water into bones explores the spiritual importance of water in madagascar families in northern madagascar conceptualize water as a spiritual realm where magical creatures and some ancestors live and believe that infants are born with a special connection to the spirit world that makes them still full of water mbola rano and lacking bones over the course of their lives the water is transformed into bone and lives end as entombed bones which symbolize their legacy as ancestors and become objects of their descendants care and remembrance author erin nourse examines the ways that malagasy women in the northern port city of diégo suarez actively enable their infants to acquire bones and establish belonging within their communities navigating diverse social environments that enable them to draw from various religious ethnic and familial traditions to welcome babies into their families malagasy mothers secure their children s status as distinctive individuals who are also firmly grounded in their ancestral legacies water into bones reveals the vast possibilities for creating community identity and sacred power through the personal experiences of northern malagasy women during pregnancy childbirth and parenthood

the volume constitutes klaus fiedler s crowning contribution to scholarship essays in the first half of the book focus on malawian christianity and how contrasting powers gospel and secular engage each other creating social political and cultural conflict in the process in the second half fiedler examines general missiologial themes these essays provide a broader missiologial background offering a theoretical framework necessary for appreciating the essays in the first half he concludes with a chapter that reviews selected seminal books on themes under study throughout the volume fiedler applies the restorationist revival theory he constructed in the story of faith missions an earlier 1994 work putting emphasis on non classical missions and churches not systematically covered in earlier scholarship this volume the first of its kind on malawian christianity will long remain an indispensable text for those interested in missiology and malawian christianity

beginning in the late 1970s and early 1980s significant numbers of haitian

immigrants began to arrive and settle in miami overcoming some of the most foreboding obstacles ever to face immigrants in america they their children and now their grandchildren as well as more recently arriving immigrants from haiti have diversified socioeconomically together they have made south florida home to the largest population of native born haitians and diasporic haitians outside of the caribbean and one of the most significant caribbean immigrant communities in the world religion has played a central role in making all of this happen crossing the water and keeping the faith is a historical and ethnographic study of haitian religion in immigrant communities based on fieldwork in both miami and haiti as well as extensive archival research where many studies of haitian religion limit themselves to one faith rey and stepick explore catholicism protestantism and vodou in conversation with one another suggesting that despite the differences between these practices the three faiths ultimately create a sense of unity fulfillment and self worth in haitian communities this meticulously researched and vibrantly written book contributes to the growing body of literature on religion among new immigrants as well as providing a rich exploration of haitian faith communities

the christian faith is comprehensive and diverse so the question what the centre is can be asked different answers have been given to which this book adds another the venture of the christian faith is missions following kenneth scott latourette s thesis that the holy spirit moves forward the history of the church by bringing in ever new revivals which produce ever new organisations therefore missions are not the children of the churches but of the revivals and africa was not evangelised by the european and american churches but by the europeans and american mission societies

every society has its own definition of a normal and an abnormal human condition for persons living with mental disorders these concepts have a tremendous impact this study investigates how the abnormal mind is culturally defined in malaŵi south eastern africa based on anthropological techniques such as interviews participant observation and archive research it explores the different social dimensions of mental disorder e g its reflection in traditional dance rituals in behavioural rules during pregnancy or in the healing ministry of independent churches it demonstrates how local explanations of mental disorder be it witchcraft an angry ancestor or the will of god determine the social acceptance of an affected person s condition recent processes of cultural change however strengthen the pluralism of malaŵian religious landscape opening the local debate to an ever wider range of interpretations

brigid m sackey s book is a comprehensive analysis of gender relations in religion in ghana using gendered anthropological tools of rare insight and originality the book chronicles the efforts of men and women who bring a repackaged and customized christianity and health delivery to meet with the specific cultural needs sackey disabuses notions of the helplessness of women in ghana specifically and africa in general as it highlights women s initiatives and assertiveness as healers and leaders of the churches they have founded in addition to their increased involvement and participation in gender discourses and social change sackey also addresses the question of hiv and the aids epidemic detailing how the churches through the specific leadership of women are supporting a national campaign on the disease basing her research on an exhaustive library of oral history ethnography theory and case studies sackey has brilliantly chronicled the relentless proliferation of and innovations in african independent churches and their impact on the national health delivery system and its development

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
