for many fans and casual observers professional sports and violence are deeply connected violence on the field has real consequences for players notably in the form of life altering injuries from concussions off the field in the last several decades scores of athletes have committed violent acts from domestic abuse and sexual assault to animal abuse and murder beyond athletes sport also serves as a site of political and structural violence from the displacement and hyperpolicing of everyday people for mega events to the sportwashing of environmentally harmful industries daniel sailofsky examines the endemic violence in professional sports and argues that while related to masculinity misogyny and individual factors like alcohol consumption and gambling it is most intimately tied to capitalism and to capitalist modes of consumption and profit sailofsky explains how capitalism creates the conditions for violence to thrive and uncovers how sports leaders coaches league officials and team owners obfuscate these relationships to avoid accountability from minor league baseball exploitation to spectator hooliganism sailofsky shows the connections between the business of sports and violence but also more importantly he imagines new forms of sport that are not places of harm

interest in women s sport has increased in recent years this has resulted in more attention and in depth discussions around increasing opportunities and access for female sports participants across all levels of sport the 2024 olympic games in paris will be the first olympics to achieve gender parity with an equal number of male and female participants anticipated to compete competitions such as the fifa women s world cup and the netball world cup were features of women s sports in 2023 these events have seen more female athlete role models emerge there is evidence showing that female participation in sports is increasing across different sports and different levels of participation an increase in female participants is accompanied by an increase in coaches who are coaching females women s sports might bear some similarities to the male equivalents but social economic physiological and psychological differences as well as alterations in sports rules are factors for
