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politics at the state and local level has never been more interesting than in our devolutionary age this popular text is the most concise readable and current introduction to the field now in its ninth edition the book keeps its focus on the varied and changing political and economic environments in which state and local governments function and their strengths and weaknesses in key areas of public policy the text is enlivened by boxed sections that relate individual experiences or highlight particular issues and developments topics covered in this edition

include the drive toward devolution in the federal system fiscal constraints political accountability affirmative action majority minority districts and changing approaches to welfare education land use and law enforcement

this book is the first of its kind to take concepts directly from the most commonly used textbooks in state and local politics and apply them directly to current events it presents twelve chapters of case studies richly detailing key topics ranging from how the comparative method can be used to understand the similarities and differences between diverse places to a look at how state governments have taken the lead on covid 19 environmental policy civil rights gun control college tuition regulation cybersecurity and elections sex offenders and many more subjects of contemporary interest it devotes a complete chapter to local level politics in nevada florida and iowa and wraps up with a unique chapter on regional governance bridging between states and localities this detailed and highly readable book is designed to complement traditional state and local textbooks it is also of interest to students of public administration public policy urban politics and intro to american politics

this book on black churches and urban politics uses case studies from various cities to examine the strategies and tactics of activist clergy and congregations these case studies illustrate how black activist clergy and congregations negotiate the political terrains of their respective cities the cases show that the political culture of a city whether that culture is shaped by machine politics a legacy of political protest racial and ethnic factionalism or a city whose power resides in the mayor s office rather than the city council chamber can influence the tactics of activist clergy and congregations these cases also show how strategies and tactics vary across congregations as well as within and across cities not only do activist churches emphasize political empowerment or economic development their tactics to pursue their goals may take different forms they can form coalitions with other churches and or political organizations lobby public officials use personal appeals to persuade politicians or mobilize voters for candidates who support the congregation s agenda by taking stock of the strategies that activist black clergy and congregations adopt and the tactics they use to research their goals the cases in this book highlight nuances in black clergy and church activism that are captured beyond a single case or a focus on national politics the three sections of black churches and local politics examine the many ways that black activist clergy and congregations voice their concerns in urban politics the tactics explored are the use of personal influence by activist ministers the formation of coalitions with churches and community organizations and pressure groups that lobby government institutions and leaders on behalf of minority communities

with articles by a high quality set of contributors including richard sakwa darrell slider and vladimir gel man this book explores the increasingly authoritarian character of putin s rule especially in his second term since 2004

this book is about why and how central and local governments clash over important national policy decisions its empirical focus is on the local politics of japan which has significantly shaped and been shaped by larger developments in national politics the book argues that since the

1990s changes in the national political arena fiscal and administrative decentralization as well as broader socio economic developments have led to a decoupling of once closely integrated national and local party systems in japan such decoupling has led to a breakdown of symbiotic relations between the centre and regions in its place are increasing strains between national and local governments leading to greater intra party conflict inter governmental conflicts and more chief executives with agendas and resources increasingly autonomous of the national ruling party although being a book primarily focused on the japanese case the study seeks to contribute to a broader understanding of how local partisans shape national policy making the book theorizes and investigates how the degree of state centralization vertical integration for party organizations and partisan congruence in different levels of government affect inter governmental relations japan s experience is compared with germany canada and the uk to explore sources of multi level policy conflict chapter 1 of this book is freely available as a downloadable open access pdf at taylorfrancis com under a creative commons attribution non commercial no derivatives cc by nc nd 4 0 license
