a computer network is defined as a digital communications network which allows sharing of information and resources between nodes the network between these nodes could be either wired optical wireless or a combination of them the nodes could include a variety of devices such as servers personal computers networking hardware etc depending upon the size of the networks or the number of devices connected they can be classified into four categories namely personal area network pan local area network lan metropolitan area network man and wide area network wan they can also be classified on the basis of the layout arrangements into bus star ring mesh and tree topology computer networks have many applications such as access to world wide instant messaging e mail and shared use of devices like fax machines printers storage servers etc the

in this paper we explore the properties of the global banking network using cross border bank lending data for 184 countries over 1978 2009 specifically we analyze financial interconnectedness using network metrics of centrality connectivity and clustering we document a relatively unstable global banking network with structural breaks in network indicators identifying several waves of capital flows interconnectedness rankings especially for borrowers are relatively volatile over the period connectivity tends to fall during and after systemic banking crises and sovereign debt crises the 2008 09 global financial crisis stands out as an unusually large perturbation to the cross border banking network

with future competitive landscape shifting from competition between companies themselves to trading partner networks understanding and mastering process design and change is becoming more critical than ever in order to succeed companies are starting to weave their key business processes into hard to imitate strategic capabilities that distingu
