adventurous colleagues for his heresy the flamboyant sorokin was condemned and driven to the periphery of a profession anxious for legitimacy as a science as a result sorokin s ideas have been consistently ignored and misunderstood for more than a quarter century based on exhaustive research in sorokin s papers and the harvard archives as well as interviews with sorokin s surviving family members former students and colleagues this biography restores sorokin to his rightful place in the pantheon of american intellectuals
