in sugar elizabeth abbott takes a spoonful of sugar tells its extraordinary story from its origins in the south pacific to the way it transformed eating habits in the 19th century fuelled the industrial revolution generated a brutal new form of slavery colonial oppression in the developing world

sugar offers a compelling and surprising look at the sweet commodity from the ways in which it africanized the cane fields of the caribbean to how it fueled the industrial revolution and jump started the fast food craze

renowned food historian neil buttery takes a look at some of the lesser known elements of the history of sugar delving into the murky and mysterious aspects of its phenomenal rise from the first cultivation of the sugar cane plant in papua new guinea in 8000 bce to its integral part of the cultural fabric of life in the west at whatever cost the dark history of sugar is one of exploitation of slaves and workers of the environment and of the consumer wars have been fought over it and it is responsible for what is potentially the planet s greatest health crisis and yet we cannot get enough of it for sugar and sweetness has cast its spell over us all it is comfort and we reminisce fondly about the sweets cakes puddings and fizzy drinks of our childhoods with dewy eyed nostalgia the very word sweet is used as a synonym for good and innocent in this book neil buttery argues that sugar is nothing of the sort

serving students and general readers alike this encyclopedia addresses the myriad and profound ways foods have shaped the world we inhabit from prehistory to the present written with the needs of students in mind foods that changed history how foods shaped civilization from the ancient world to the present presents nearly 100 entries on foods that have shaped history fascinating topics that are rarely addressed in detail in traditional history texts in learning about foods and their importance readers will gain valuable insight into other areas such as religious movements literature economics technology and the human condition itself readers will learn how the potato for example changed lives in drastic ways in northern europe particularly ireland and how the potato famine led to the foundation of the science of plant pathology which now affects how scientists and governments consider the dangers of genetic uniformity the entries document how the consumption of tea and spices fostered global exploration and how citrus fruits led to the prevention of scurvy this book helps students acquire fundamental information about the role of foods in shaping world history and it promotes critical thinking about that topic

where his students included one future u s president as well as others who aspired to the office he reveals much about the inner workings of ivy league education and tells of controversies over the vietnam war and the black panthers his role in eugene mccarthy s presidential campaign and how he searched for common ground between reactionary faculty and radical students more than a recounting of a singular life blum s story explains how political history was researched and written during the second half of the twentieth century describing how the discipline evolved gained ascendancy and was challenged as historical fashions changed it also offers revealing glimpses of such prominent academics as kingman brewster arthur schlesinger jr c vann woodward and william sloan coffin over a distinguished career blum witnessed considerable change in elite educational institutions where minorities and women were grossly underrepresented when he first entered academia in a memoir brimming with insight and laced with humor he looks back at the academy not a refuge from reality but an alternative reality as he reflects upon his intellectual journey and his contributions to the study and writing of twentieth century american history

document from the year 2018 in the subject english language and literature studies literature grade 2 3 cardiff university course english literature language english abstract brother jacob shows an example of the representation of sugar in a small town in britain itself whereas the journal of a west indian proprietor rather represents the sugar production and life on the plantations in the colonies this essay will look at different representations of sugar in the two works and will compare them to each other there is something about sugarcane he isn't what he seems at first sight the sweet pleasure of sugar as we know it today and as we use it in our every day life might seem nothing but that an innocent pleasure but in times of the british colonies where the history of sugar begins it was so much more than that the background of sugar is marked by oppression and violence george eliot's brother jacob and matthew lewis journal of a west india proprietor are just two examples of literature which tell us about the representation of sugar and which make it clear that sugar isn't what it might seem both books have been released in the 19th century with one difference though brother jacob was written after the emancipation act took place whereas lewis journal was written years before the two stories show different representations of sugar under the light of slavery and colonialism since the 17th century sugar plantations in the west indies were the main source of work and profit as the west indies were british colonies many british businessmen became plantation owners their slaves worked under different conditions for their masters most of them suffering a lot but when the sugar was imported into great britain nothing reminded about the brutal way in which it was produced anymore on july 28 1833 the emancipation act was passed in england to take effect on august 1 1834 but it emancipated only children under six and apprenticed domestic and non field workers to their former masters for a period of four years and plantation workers for six years this was a huge step against slavery but still the slaves had to stay on the sugar plantations and some of them still worked under bad conditions

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
