destruction of the jewish people rather the author of hebrews stresses the fulfillment of specific jewish institutions for the benefit of the jews it is this idea of fulfillment that rules out the charge that the epistle promotes the supercession of the jewish people because of god s great love for his people he has provided a superior way by which his people can draw near to him from the conclusion
