this volume is a study of how targum lamentations tglam interpreted and responded to the theologically challenging message of the book of lamentations through various exegetical techniques the targumist has transformed lamentations into a rabbinic program for the synagogue the first section examines how the targumist demonstrated that israel herself is responsible for the destruction of jerusalem and thus absolves god of all culpability yet the targumist continues to assert that god is the ultimate source of all history the second section examines how the targumist depicts god as orchestrating events through his action and abstention finally the targum argues that reconciliation with god can only come about through repentance and rabbinic worship a new translation and a transcription of tglam from codex urbinas hebr 1 is included

apocryphal traditions often shared by jews and christians have played a significant role in the history of both religions the 26 essays in this volume examine regional and linguistic developments in ethiopia egypt syria armenia the balkans and italy dissenting groups such as the samaritans followers of john the baptist and mediæval dualists are also discussed furthermore the book looks at interactions of judaism and christianity with the religions of iran seldom verified or authorized and frequently rejected by churches apocryphal texts had their own process of development undergoing significant transformations the book shows how apocryphal accounts could become a medium of literary and artistic elaboration and mythological creativity local adaptations of biblical stories indicate that copyists authors and artists conceived of themselves as living not in a post biblical era but in direct continuity with biblical personages

darrell l bock examines the historical cultural background to one of the most significant moments in religious history the final jewish examination of jesus as presented in mark 14 61 64 he traces the history of interpretive debate surrounding this controversial text and notes that a consensus is emerging that the key statement is the discussion of exaltation using ps 110 1 and dan 7 13 so the author engages in two detailed treatments of the themes of blasphemy and exaltation within judaism he works from the hebrew scriptures all the way through the rabbinic materials including both talmuds and the midrashim the study represents the first thorough treatment of blasphemy from this material and examines over 150 texts on this theme particular attention is given to whether blasphemy is merely verbal misuse of the divine name or can include the presence of certain statements or acts that are deemed offensive to god s honor it is noted that these additional categories exist in the culture and are present in a variety of texts that are contemporaneous to the period with examples from josephus and philo being predominant then the attention turns to the theme of exaltation a specific concern here is who gets to go directly into god s presence what do they do how long are they there are there obstacles to their presence is there opposition to these kinds of portrayals here the key texts include the exagoge of moses the enoch son of man portrait of 1 enoch and the metatron portrait of 3 enoch this background is then applied to the study of mark 14 first as an expression of mark s message and then to the historical portrait of the scene
