this original book offers a meaningful window into the lived experiences of children from immigrant families providing a holistic profound portrait of their literacy practices as situated within social cultural and political frames drawing on reports from five years of an ongoing longitudinal research project involving students from immigrant families across their elementary school years each chapter explores a unique set of questions about the students experiences and offers a rich data set of observations interviews and student created artifacts authors apply different sociocultural sociomaterial and sociopolitical frameworks to better understand the dimensions of the children's experiences the multitude of approaches applied demonstrates how viewing the same data through distinct lenses is a powerful way to uncover the differences and comparative uses of these theories through such varied lenses it becomes apparent how the complexities of lived experiences inform and improve our understanding of teaching and learning and how our understanding of multifaceted literacy practices affects students social worlds and identities children in immigrant families becoming literate is a much needed resource for scholars professors researchers and graduate students in language and literacy education english education and teacher education

worldwide more parents are opting for immersion pre schooling for their children in order to benefit from its linguistic educational and cultural benefits this immersion can be either bilingual or monolingual aimed at early second language learning or at language maintenance offering minority language children mother tongue support and enrichment this book examines some of the key issues and policy concerns relating to immersion education in the early years the term itself can be difficult in some political contexts as can the

differing outcomes noted by studies comparing monolingual programmes and bilingual programmes for minority language children the importance of training in immersion methodology for educators is discussed as is the need to adapt preschool pedagogical practices to the immersion context in order to provide optimal input for young language learners one of the most pressing discussions surrounds differentiated provision ensuring that the varying needs of children with language impairment typical second language learners and mother tongue speakers with significant socioeconomic or linguistic disadvantages are all met overall the book explores the challenges currently facing the sector particularly with regard to training and professional development for practitioners and the provision of appropriate materials in less widely used languages given the documented benefit of high quality immersion pre schooling this book fulfils an urgent need to increase the recognition of the sector this book was published as a special issue of international journal of bilingual education and bilingualism
