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once again author ralph milton brings his enormous talent as storyteller to the task of retelling biblical stories based on the bestselling family story bible the lectionary story bible includes many new and wonderfully engaging stories from both the hebrew and new testament scriptures at least one but usually two stories from the lections are included for each sunday of the church year making lectionarys story bible a complete lectionary resource for christian educators camp leaders worship leaders and families who want to share their faith at home the book also includes a scripture index of the stories included in the collection for non lectionary settings and uses adept at handling even difficult material ralph milton writes stories that are positive and life affirming use inclusive language and portray a god of love to children and adults alike margaret kyle has created many new illustrations brimming with the energy curiosity and joy that so characterizes her work lectionary story bible year a is the first in a series that will cover all three years of the lectionary the complete

set will be an indispensable resource for anyone who wants to share faith stories with children and make the bible relevant to young people today

this is a book of insightful often humorous and always grace filled poems for each sunday of the church year and occasional other days based on one or more texts for year a of the revised common lectionary original testament gospel letters and psalms each poem reveals surprises about god much like the proclamations made by the biblical writers for preachers the poems here will be a joyful springboard to the sermon each one a mini sermon in itself and for people in the pews a brand new way of thinking about the bible the index of 124 biblical references will make the book usable at any time with titles like the once and future comeuppance of the butters what s really original here three drinking limericks and they thought it was the feds these poems will help the reader discover the god known and shown by jesus and the earliest faith communities as amazing abundant boundary pushing and bold

in this companion volume to the word in the wind sermons for the lectionary year a advent through eastertide bruce taylor provides a collection of theologically rich sacramentally sensitive and biblically centered sermons for the sundays and feast days for pentecost and the remainder of the liturgical year commonly referred to as ordinary time the compilation includes a sampling of story sermons and in an appendix to the lectionary based homilies a sermon that was delivered at the invitation of the presbyterian church usa as part of the preparation for the denomination s general assembly in 2008 challenging the church to remember and remain faithful to its prophetic heritage using the full range of old testament epistle and gospel readings commended by the common lectionary revised this collection encourages preachers to use the lectionary as an opportunity to explore homiletically the whole range of scriptural themes for their congregations and offers all readers thoughtful reflections on living faithfully in regular engagement with word and sacrament

convenient and user friendly this one volume guide provides resources for the entire three year lectionary cycle including midweek festival days brief comments on each of the three daily biblical texts identify themes for the day musical settings for the appointed psalm are offered organ music appropriate for the day is suggested anthems for the day are graded according to difficulty and hymns of the day are keyed to several hymnals pastors music leaders and worship committees will find much practical assistance for worship planning in the handbook for the common lectionary

psalms for preaching and worship a key addition to the critically acclaimed three volume lectionary commentary despite the rich resources available for studying the psalms few are as focused on their place in worship and preaching as is this volume the responsorial psalms of the revised common lectionary are here taken up in careful and often illuminating interpretation with attention also to their interaction with other lectionary texts the many ways that psalms can function meaningfully in the liturgical life of congregations are explored especially in john witvliet s concluding section i know of no work that combines practice and substance better than this lectionary commentary patrick d miller princeton theological seminary a fascinating book well organized well written and edited thorough and informative an excellent resource not only for preachers using the revised common lectionary but also for those wishing to preach a series of sermons on

something is wrong people are going missing right in front of your eyes one minute they are staring back at you from their favorite pew the next sunday you are looking at an empty spot in that pew is there a way to determine ahead of time which members are the likely religious dropouts often the clues are clearly visible but can you recognize them what s more do you know what you can do now to keep your missing members from drifting away the secret lies in knowing and understanding the attitudes and belief systems that people hold because certain sets of attitudes are linked to inactivity a detailed examination of this distressingly common experience solving the missing member puzzle can help you spot potential dropouts in advance learn the reasons why they become inactive and counteract the process with a proactive strategy for reaching them while they are still within your grasp based on blind interviews with individuals from ten different congregations it reveals the underlying attitudes and belief systems that encourage or discourage dropping out of church solving the missing member puzzle is a valuable tool for leaders of any church or organization it shows how you can develop more faithful members and assists in their growth participation and retention don t wait until people drop out before you take action learn ways to anticipate which members of your congregation might become inactive and the preventive measures that you can take to help keep them in the pews arlon k stubbe is the pastor of christ lutheran church in sharon pennsylvania he previously served parishes in michigan he is also the author of shaping the word lptc publishing he is a graduate of carthage college and the lutheran school of theology at chicago
