seven historians one geographer and a paleoclimatologist contribute a wealth of observation analysis and commentary on the environmental characteristics and history of the southern plains they address such themes as failing communities scarce water endangered species and disappearing ways of life and the possible results of these developments not only in the southern plains but elsewhere on the globe book jacket

since its first publication in 1991 this history of early san antonio has won a 1992 citation from the san antonio conservation society and a presidio la bahía award from the sons of the republic of texas

most people think of George McJannet or the Buffalo Soldiers when they think about African American history in New Mexico but their history is richer and more complex and continues to this day this collection is aimed at providing an overview of the dynamic presence of African Americans throughout the state and its history provided by publisher

there is the story the Lone Star State likes to tell about itself and then there is the reality a Texas past that bears little resemblance to the manly Anglo myth of Texas exceptionalism that maintains a firm grip on the state's historical imagination Lone Star Mind takes aim at this traditional narrative holding both academic and lay historians accountable for the ways in which they craft the state's story a clear sighted far reaching work of intellectual history this book marshals a wide array of pertinent scholarship analysis and original ideas to point the way toward a new usable past that twenty first century Texans will find relevant Ty Cashion fixes the Lone Star in his crosshairs in particular laying bare the conceptual deficiencies of the romantic and mythic narrative the book has served to codify since its first publication in 1968 at the same time Cashion explores the reasons why the collective efforts of university trained scholars have failed to diminish the appeal of the state's iconic popular culture despite the fuller and more accurate record these historians have produced framing the search for a collective Texan identity in the context of a post Christian age and the end of Anglo male hegemony Lone Star Mind illuminates the many historiographical issues besetting the study of American history that will resonate with scholars in other fields as well Cashion proposes that a cultural history approach focusing on the self interests of all Texans is capable of telling a more complete story a story that captures present day realities

organized in two major sections this definitive reference work provides historical essays by leading scholars in the field and surveys of the principal archival holdings in Texas with special emphasis on those significant to the history of the state the essays covering the most important chronological periods and including some special topics offer up to date summaries of the major works and most significant interpretations in the historical literature focusing on the political economic social cultural and intellectual concerns of the past the second section provides an overview of the major archives within the state which will enable the researcher to locate primary sources each article is written by a historian or an archivist with special knowledge of the archives and includes an introduction to the collection location of the archive hours of operation and a wealth of other useful information there are also brief discussions of topics that might be developed for further study from the resources of the particular archive

the outbreak of war in Europe in the summer of 1914 surprised Americans although most hoped to avoid involvement in the conflict the German submarine campaign against shipping in the North Atlantic brought the United States into the war in April 1917 as an ally of the British French Italians and Russians before World War I ended in November 1918 the United States mobilized

over four million men and suffered over 350 000 casualties including 120 000 who were killed in action or died from disease 200 000 texans served in the american armed forces during what contemporaries called the great war over 5 000 texans in uniform died during the conflict four texans were awarded the medal of honor for gallantry in action several texans received the distinguished service cross the distinguished service medal or the french croix de guerre three qualified as aces by shooting down five enemy aircraft military historian ralph a wooster describes the role texans played in the war both overseas in the major battles and campaigns and on the home front producing the materials needed to carry on a modern war he shows that the mobilization of the mind and spirit during the war kindled the growth of patriotism and brought texans into the mainstream of american life for the first time since the american civil war
