forging of a codified language of divine kingship this pioneering investigation which links monumental art to the matrices of political economic and supernatural exchange offers an important new understanding of a region time period and group of monuments that played a key role in the history of mesoamerica and continue to intrigue scholars within the field of mesoamerican studies
