an early icon of feminist art history the work of artemisia gentileschi has been largely obscured by the sensational details of her life in this volume the contributors attempt to give a more balanced view to approach a genuine appreciation of artemisia's considerable artistic talents

baroque depictions of violence are often dismissed as over the top and excessive their material richness and exciting visual complexity together with the visceral engagement they demand from beholders are usually explained in literature as reflecting the presumed violence of early modern society this book explores the

intersection between materiality excess and violence in seventeenth century paintings through a close analysis of some of the most iconic works of the period baroque paintings expose or reference their materiality by insisting on various physical changes wrought through violence this study approaches violence as the work of materiality which has the potential to analogously stage pictorial surfaces as corporeal surfaces where paint becomes flayed flesh canvas threads ruptured skin and red paint spilt blood

women's vibrant presence in the italian renaissance has long been overlooked with attention focused mainly on the artistic and intellectual achievements of their male counterparts during this period however italian women excelled especially as writers and nowhere were they more expressive than in their letters in a corresponding renaissance letters written by italian women 1375 1650 lisa kaborycha considers the lives and cultural contributions revealed by these women in their own words through their correspondence by turns highly personal didactic or devotional these letters expose the daily realities of women's lives and their feelings ideas and reactions to the complex world in which they lived through their letters women emerge not merely as bystanders but as true cultural protagonists in the italian renaissance a corresponding renaissance is divided into eight thematic chapters featuring fifty five letters that are newly translated into english many for the first time ever each of the letters is annotated and includes a brief biographical introduction and bibliographic references the women come from all walks of life saints poets courtesans and countesses and from every geographic area of italy chronologically they span the entire renaissance with the majority representing the sixteenth century approximately one third of the selections are well known letters such as those of catherine of siena veronica franco and isabella d este the rest are lesser known previously untranslated or otherwise inaccessible

this book is a genealogical study of confession drawing on the work of michel foucault as well as the history of western confessional writings from ancient greece to contemporary pop culture this book challenges the transhistorical and commonsense views of confession as an innate impulse resulting in the psychological liberation of the confessing subject on the contrary confessional desire is argued to be contingent and constraining and alternatives to confessional subjectivity are explored

offering close exegesis of specific passages from the hebrew bible and a discussion of the interpretation and appropriation of these ancient texts by post biblical jewish writers and by other creative contributors from outside the jewish tradition this study explores topics in religious ethics social justice political ethics reproductive ethics economic ethics issues in ecology gender and sexuality killing and dying and

reproductive ethics certain goals inform all the chapters the interest in tracing recurring themes concerning the definition of the good and the various ways in which jewish thinkers rely on the more ancient material and appropriate it the links between areas in ethics explored e g between gender and reproductive ethics or war views and attitudes to political ethics and environmental ethics each essay however is a self contained study as well the author has carved out particular biblical texts or themes in order to explore them in depth with special interest in the meanings and messages that pertain to ancient israelite writers varied presentation of matters in ethics
