an early icon of feminist art history the work of artemisia gentileschi has been largely obscured by the sensational details of her life in this volume the contributors attempt to give a more balanced view to approach a genuine appreciation of artemisia's considerable artistic talents

baroque depictions of violence are often dismissed as over the top and excessive their material richness and exciting visual complexity together with the visceral engagement

they demand from beholders are usually explained in literature as reflecting the presumed violence of early modern society this book explores the intersection between materiality excess and violence in seventeenth century paintings through a close analysis of some of the most iconic works of the period baroque paintings expose or reference their materiality by insisting on various physical changes wrought through violence this study approaches violence as the work of materiality which has the potential to analogously stage pictorial surfaces as corporeal surfaces where paint becomes flayed flesh canvas threads ruptured skin and red paint spilt blood

this book is a genealogical study of confession drawing on the work of michel foucault as well as the history of western confessional writings from ancient greece to contemporary pop culture this book challenges the transhistorical and commonsense views of confession as an innate impulse resulting in the psychological liberation of the confessing subject on the contrary confessional desire is argued to be contingent and constraining and alternatives to confessional subjectivity are explored

this book offers a new intersectional feminist approach to utilising and interpreting the visual reception of mary magdalene through employment of liberative reception criticism which develops traditional reception theory in line with liberative hermeneutics via the insights of intersectionality as critical theory siobh n jolley provides a novel means of analysing how women and particularly the magdalene are imaged in christian tradition knowledge of both the biblical figure of mary magdalene and her cultural reception continue to be dominated by long discredited ideas about her life and sexuality which bear the hallmarks of their development under patriarchy through close study of relevant biblical texts and extracanonical accounts and a comprehensive survey of the magdalene s presentation in the italian art of the counter reformation jolley demonstrates that the patriarchal portrayal of the magdalene as a sexualised penitent and mournful witness to the resurrection is sustained by its mythic attachment to biblical text rather than adopting the same tropes uncritically we are invited to look again at artworks and related texts in order to explore what happens when the influence of patriarchy is actively and intersectionally resisted ultimately the magdalene is transformed from a reductive and patriarchally mythologised figure to a multidimensional character who is relatable and liberative as an exemplar

offering close exegesis of specific passages from the hebrew bible and a discussion of

the interpretation and appropriation of these ancient texts by post biblical jewish writers and by other creative contributors from outside the jewish tradition this study explores topics in religious ethics social justice political ethics reproductive ethics economic ethics issues in ecology gender and sexuality killing and dying and reproductive ethics certain goals inform all the chapters the interest in tracing recurring themes concerning the definition of the good and the various ways in which jewish thinkers rely on the more ancient material and appropriate it the links between areas in ethics explored e g between gender and reproductive ethics or war views and attitudes to political ethics and environmental ethics each essay however is a self contained study as well the author has carved out particular biblical texts or themes in order to explore them in depth with special interest in the meanings and messages that pertain to ancient israelite writers varied presentation of matters in ethics
