practitioner from all desire except union with the divine the author includes an evocative ritual from the nirrutara tantra never before translated into any western language containing devotions to the 64 yoginis according to matsyendranath founder of the kaula path offering devotional chants meditations and mudras specific to tantric worship of kali this empowering book provides practices and teachings for those on the tantric path to liberation
