

The Catch Colt

this gripping crime thriller plunges readers into the sun soaked yet shadowy underbelly of florida s gulf coast where paradise masks a thriving human trafficking ring operating beneath the city s surface the story interweaves the fates of alena hernandez a vulnerable college freshman nicole beemer a relentless detective haunted by her own family tragedy and colton colt flynn a battle scarred recently retired swat officer drawn back into danger by loyalty and unfinished business colt flynn a decorated swat veteran and nicole beemer s former field training officer is reluctantly pulled from retirement when he receives a desperate call for help beemer knowing she can t trust her own department had arranged for a friend to contact colt if she went missing realizing the danger beemer faces and the rot within the

system colt assembles a team of trusted allies including his old swat partner bear bennet dhs agent tim tech savvy hacker mo and anti government gun nut ben to mount an off the books rescue

once miranda felt a little exposed miranda hill can t believe her eyes her cocky ex boyfriend pro hockey player dane croft is back in bluebonnet texas after all these years he ditched her and their little town just as some rather shocking photos showed up on the internet for everyone to see miranda wasn t so lucky stuck in bluebonnet and left to fend for herself she s never really shaken the scandal or his betrayal after nine long years dane s back and she has the chance to turn the tables on him it s time she gets even former nhl hotshot playboy dane croft has returned home to open a survival training school on an old ranch and reinvent himself when his former high school girlfriend enrolls in the program he has no idea that miranda s plan is to get him in a compromising position not the one he s imagining anyway but soon miranda realizes that to carry out her deviously sexy revenge she ll have to get up close and personal with dane all over again being a good girl got her nowhere for nine years now it s time to be a little naughty but falling in love with the man who broke her heart was never part of the plan

the story owner of the largest ranch in his part of wyoming jepson heath is a proud and determined man he manages his affairs with a firm hand including the engagement of his beautiful daughter letty the only man jepson considers to be good e

one dark vacant nevada night cattle rancher henry mcbride closes his eyes only to open them and find his life suddenly in shambles with everything that means anything lost to him forever overwhelmed by grief and haunted by guilt henry drives away from his past as far and as fast as he can jobs towns and whiskey come and go he always tells himself he ll stay just long enough to earn the money he needs to buy his next drink somewhere else on down the road but guest ranch owner jessie king extends an open and forgiving hand to the cowboy and the arrival of a young mustang stallion also wounded and alone ignites a flicker of recognition in henry like him broken with jessie s powerful ability to connect with horses and her gentle attempts to connect with henry time slows enough on the ranch to heal just a little but jessie too has an imperfect past and when her former ranch manager returns with murder in mind the fragile world she henry and the stallion are building together threatens to come crashing down

fourth grader ellie james and her horse dream are best friends forever but when her human best friend colt starts acting strange ellie determines to fix his problem she tries to find the perfect horse for colt but how ellie s brother is struggling to stay on his baseball team her father is fighting to hold onto his job at the jingle bells

ad agency and her mother is volunteering at the cat farm and the worm ranch so ellie is on her own or is she join ellie and colt in their exciting horse loving adventures

abandonment bigamy crib deaths single mothers struggling to raise families these are not new age phenomena mollie tidwell knew them all as well as she knew her own family but how well was that in the late 1800s these truths were swept under the parlor rug mollie tidwell was born near springfield illinois an only child when she was four her mother died and she was given away to the indians in summary this sounds a fearful thing but in reality it was mollie's rebirth surrounded by love she became a young woman of promise whose only goal was to marry and find security and love in her own home she came the full circle in adjusting to her different lives from the white society to indian to quarter blood to white but the cherokee indian teachings were the lasting influences for her the story finally had to be written when a relative shared a memory that mollie had told of her grandfather who would ride a tall white horse to the edge of the tidwell property for a secret visit he would bring her an apple for a treat the theme of this story mollie's family became her possessions when death tried to take them away she would not let them go what she had to learn was that your children were a gift to be returned to god before she died she realized that she must forgive them for dying and release their earth bound spirits it was a race against time for her

shirlene dalton has it all a dream marriage to a man who spoils her rotten and the most outrageous mansion bramble texas has ever seen but when her husband unexpectedly dies shirlene finds herself right back where she started in a rundown trailer on the wrong side of the tracks never the type to let a little bad luck and a whole heap of heartache get her down shirlene is ready to prove to the local gossips she can make it on her own until she ends up living next door to the most tempting cowboy in town billy wilkes has a score to settle and a plan to wipe bramble right off the map but when his sexy redheaded neighbor figures out what he s up to his good ol boy charm won t be enough to save him with the town on his tail billy will have to come clean quick or kiss shirlene goodbye

a powerful debut novel of friendship love and family set in the segregated pre civil war south this is a promise bridge and it bridges a promise flowing from your heart to mine it can t never be broken the promise is part of you now understand thus begins an unlikely friendship between hannelore blessing a plantation mistress and a slave girl named livie as the young women are launched on a harrowing journey of awakening filled with shared risks and nurtured promises amid whispers of the underground railroad and the rising tension preceding the civil war they discover their ability to trust love and ultimately take action aided by colt a devoted suitor hoping to win her heart hannah comes to understand that true friendship means letting go so that livie can be free to find a life and destiny all her own however a vicious slave catcher stalks the two women and his unseemly motives and relentless pursuit threaten all that hannah holds dear as well as put her loved ones in unimaginable danger

the barefoot bandit tells the riveting true story of colton harris moore america s twenty first century outlaw born into a poor family marred by alcohol abuse colt had the local sheriff after him before the age of ten colt survived by breaking into homes to forage for food and learned to evade the police by melting into the pacific northwest wilds as a teenager he escalated to stealing cars boats and identities an extensive manhunt finally caught colt but he escaped juvenile prison and fled to nearby orcas island where he assured his place alongside outlaw legends such as d b cooper by stealing an airplane without ever having a formal flight lesson and that was just the beginning as a resident of orcas island author bob friel witnessed firsthand as local police fbi agents SWAT teams and even homeland

security helicopters pursued colt around the island colt's crime spree infuriated and terrified many locals while others sympathized with the barefoot young criminal the controversy tearing at the formerly quiet community the story gained international fame with time calling colt america's most wanted teen when he stole and crashed his third airplane after more than two years on the run in the northwest colt fled orcas and began a spectacular cross country trek friel followed the barefoot bandit all the way to the bahamas where the chase finally ended in a hail of gunfire at 3 a m on a dark sea through his personal experiences and hundreds of interviews with witnesses victims local authorities colt's family and indirectly colt himself friel gives readers an exclusive look at an outlaw legend set against the backdrop of the pacific northwest's evergreen islands where internet millionaires coexist with survivalists and ex hippies this is a gripping stranger than fiction tale about a neglected and troubled child who outfoxed the authorities gained a cult following and made the world take notice
