public notice as quickly as she became famous one reason for this was that captain nerger the raider's commander was not a publicity seeker and was not in particularly high favour in germany it was necessary to receive him with honour after he brought his ship back from such a cruise but after that he was quietly moved to an obscure post and was heard of no more the author was a prisoner aboard the raider for the last nine months of the cruise
