novel based on real events praised as nature writing at its best the wolves of paris takes readers to fifteenth century france a country so decimated by the hundred years war that its people became prey for marauding wolf packs hartford courant with france split among the english the burgundians and the forces of the weak charles vii a wolf dog rises to ensure the existence of his pack by any means necessary courtaud begins his life as the possession of a count until an attack on the castle leaves him to fend for himself to survive the huge russet colored beast ingratiates himself into a pack of wolves he will soon lead with his mate silver at his side without the wild wolf s innate fear of man and driven to starvation by vicious winters courtaud turns his pack to hunting livestock on its way to paris battles and the plague leave corpses in their path stoking the wolves lust for human flesh soon courtaud s howl alone will strike fear into the hearts of parisians prompting a king to put a price on his head and history to remember his name daniel mannix gets right inside any animal skin his hero courtaud is the most feared and celebrated of all wolves and this story of his life and times based on medieval archives should add to the fistful of awards already garnered by mannix it will haunt almost anyone st louis post dispatch

linda has an idiosyncratic home life her parents live in abandoned commune cabins in northern minnesota and are hanging on to the last vestiges of a faded counter culture world the kids at school call her freak or commie she is an outsider in all things her understanding of the world comes from her observations at school where her teacher is accused of possessing child pornography and from watching the seemingly ordinary life of a family she babysits for yet while the accusation against the teacher is perhaps more innocent than it seemed at first the ordinary family turns out to be more complicated as linda insinuates her way into the family s orbit she realises they are hiding something

promise of the wolves begins 14 000 years ago in what is now southern europe and follows the adventures of kaala a spirited young she wolf who is destined to bring wolf and human clans together born of a forbidden mixed blood litter and narrowly escaping the fate of her executed brother and sisters the orphaned kaala is allowed to join the swift river wolf pack where she must fight to prove herself and survive against the odds but when kaala rescues a human child from drowning she risks expulsion from her pack and banishment from her home in the wide valley unwittingly she has set in train a series of events which threatens the very survival of her species

this story of a horse trainer and a rich man's wife is a gorgeously written exacting exploration of duty and retribution set in dusty rural south dakota publishers weekly when fourteen year old carson fielding bought his first horse from magnus yarborough it became clear the teenager was a better judge of horses than the rich landowner was of humans years later carson now a skilled and respected horse trainer grudgingly agrees to train magnus's horses and teach his wife to ride but as carson becomes disaffected with the power hungry magnus he also grows more and more attracted to the rancher's wife and their relationship sets off a violent chain of events that unsettles their quiet town in south dakota thrown into the drama are earl walks alone a lakota trying to study his way out of the reservation and into college and willi a german exchange student confronting his family's troubled history described by howard frank mosher as the best western based fiction i've read since lonesome dove and plainsong this compelling story of love and hatred by the author of twisted tree offers fine characterizations crisp dialogue and fully realized sense of place the denver post kent meyers's new novel is the kind of book that demands and rewards fierce loyalty i instantly fell under its spell the christian science monitor
