google as a search engine quantitative findings revealed that 75 of users were aware of personalisation but 70 of these users were not always happy with the results although a general consensus was formed that personalisation was helpful in many respects it was also argued in some camps that it breached ethical boundaries overall there was a national split whether users considered personalisation ethical or not this study leaves open the debate of how we perceive google as a nation but it also gets closer to the truth of how we feel about the search engine on a personal level the research also confirms that there is plenty of opportunity to carry out further studies into this area
