dark back of time is a compelling story of the way in which reality blurs into fiction by javier marías whose highly anticipated new novel the infatuations is published in 2013 it is translated by esther allen in penguin modern classics we lose everything because everything remains except us says the mysterious narrator of this extraordinary novel which meditates on the transience chance and fragility of life as a man called javier marías recalls the strange events

and people that shaped his past including ghostly literary figures a pilot an adventurer a brother who died as a child and the king of an island in the caribbean we begin to question the nature of time memory and reality itself here the writer is both a keeper of memories and a purveyor of illusions destined to be lost in the dark back of time javier marías was born in madrid in 1951 he has published ten novels two collections of short stories and several volumes of essays his work has been translated into thirty two languages and won a dazzling array of international literary awards including the prestigious dublin impac award for a heart so white he is also a highly practised translator into spanish of english authors including joseph conrad robert louis stevenson sir thomas browne and laurence sterne i was enthralled by his strange mix of made up memories lost experiences and real life fantasies marina warner guardian he uses language like an anatomist uses a scalpel to lay bare the innermost secrets of that strangest of species the human being w g sebald author of austerlitz

reissuing five works originally published between 1937 and 1991 this collection contains books addressing the subject of time from a mostly philosophic point of view but also of interest to those in the science and mathematics worlds these texts are brought back into print in this small set of works addressing how we think about time the history of the philosophy of time the measurement of time theories of relativity and discussions of the wider thinking about time and space among other aspects one volume is a thorough bibliography collating references on the subject of time across many disciplines

between the 1930s and the invention of the internet american comics reached readers in a few distinct physical forms the familiar monthly stapled pamphlet the newspaper comics section bubblegum wrappers and bound books from gum wrappers to richie rich the materiality of cheap comics places the history of four representative comics

watchmen uncle scrooge richie rich and fleer funnies in the larger contexts of book history children s culture and consumerism to understand the roles that comics have played as very specific kinds of books while comics have received increasing amounts of scholarly attention over the past several decades their material form is a neglected aspect of how creators corporations and readers have constructed meaning inside and around narratives neale barnholden traces the unusual and surprising histories of comics ranging from the most acclaimed works to literal garbage analyzing how the physical objects containing comics change the meaning of those comics for example carl barks s uncle scrooge comics were gradually salvaged by a fan driven project an evolution that is evident when considering their increasingly expensive forms similarly watchmen has been physically made into the epitome of prestigious graphic novel by the dc comics corporation on the other hand harvey comics richie rich is typically misunderstood as a result of its own branding while fleer funnies uses its inextricable association with bubblegum to offer unexpectedly sophisticated meanings examining the bibliographical histories of each title barnholden demonstrates how the materiality of consumer culture suggests meanings to comics texts beyond the narratives

using empirical research to explore medieval writers imaginings of time this study presents a new morphology by which to study narratives of time in fifteenth century literary culture focusing on poems of john lydgate and thomas hoccleve karen smyth begins with an overview of medieval time keeping devices and considers collective and individual attitudes and perceptions of time she then examines a range of middle english authors appropriations and innovations in relation to such perceptions identifying competitions of tradition and innovation allowing for an interrogation of commonly accepted medieval theories of time an empirically based morphology emerges and is used to examine narratives of time in lydgate and hoccleve s work through a series of close readings of selected short poems and lydgate s troy book fall of princes and siege of thebes and of hoccleve s regiments of princes and series

karen smyth looks at expressions of time and examples of the authors negotiation of time consciousness illustrating how both poets manipulate a range of cultural narratives of time in order to create multiple and sometimes competing temporalities within a single poem smyth simultaneously draws attention to lydgate s and hoccleve s underestimated artistic skills and lays out a means to re evaluate medieval cultural attitudes towards time

time travel romance is not the same thing as sci fi romance though some stories may be set in an imagined future it is romantic fiction set in various different eras usually from around the sixteenth to the eighteenth centuries a woman may fall asleep in central park in the present to wake up in the arms of a scottish laird in the sixteenth century the mammoth book of time travel romance contains 25 stories of adventure and love settings include medieval scotland sixteenth century england the nineteenth century wild west some stories are set in the present and a few in the future stories include an elizabethan nobleman whisked into the present day a troubled young woman who lands in the sixteenth century able to break a curse of lost love includes stories from nina bangs jude deveraux sandra hill linda howard lynn kurland karen marie moning and many more

in medieval culture the consideration of language is deeply connected to other aspects of the system of knowledge one interesting connection takes place between theories of language and theories of larger concepts such as love and desire the syntax of desire is an interdisciplinary examination of the interlacing operation of syntax and desire in three medieval grammars theological linguistic and poetic exploring three representative aspects of medieval language theory elena lombardi uncovers the ways in which syntax and desire were interrelated in the middle ages she suggests that in augustine s theology the creative act of god in the universe emerges as a syntax that the human individual must interpret by means of desire in the linguistic theory of the modistae she sees the syntax of language as

parallel to a syntax of reality one organized by the desiring interplay of matter and form in dante s poetry she argues that the language of the fallen human is bound together by the syntax of poetry an act of desire that restores language to its primitive innocence in addition to detailed analyses of medieval texts the syntax of desire examines some aspects of the same relationship in light of contemporary linguistics philosophy of language and psychoanalysis
