for the past few decades a growing number of scholars have attempted to overthrow the traditional wellhausenian view that the so called yahwist or j source of the pentateuch is the oldest of the four major sources these scholars have argued that j was composed during the exilic or post exilic periods of ancient israel their arguments have focused on the literary historiographic and theological characteristics of j this book attempts to re evaluate on linguistic grounds such efforts to place the yahwist source in the exilic or post exilic periods the study employs the methodology developed most prominently by avi hurvitz for identifying characteristic features of post exilic hebrew late biblical hebrew this divides the language of the hebrew bible into three main chronological stages archaic biblical hebrew abh standard biblical hebrew sbh and late biblical hebrew lbh wright examines 40 features of j for which useful comparisons can be made to lbh and finds no evidence of lbh in the entire yahwist source therefore it is unlikely that j was composed during the post exilic period moreover since hurvitz has shown that the exilic period was a time of transition between sbh and lbh such that late features began to occur in exilic texts the author concludes on linguistic grounds that j was most likely composed during the pre exilic period of ancient israel
