of the three revisionist works john charmley has written about british foreign policy in the mid twentieth century this is the centrepiece the author argues that churchill deserves more credit for their finest hour than has been granted but just as his virtues were built on the heroic scale so too were his faults and failures the statesman who had struggled to destroy nazism and restore europe s balance of power ended by allowing stalin to dominate central and eastern europe this is no mere exercise in debunking in many ways the complex man presented in these pages is more interesting than the more hagiographical portraits this is not instant history run up to cause a sensation but a meticulously documented reappraisal of churchill s war leadership and of the career that led up to it nor is its tone contemptuous or vindictive the author accepts that churchill was a great man his starting point is that even great men make mistakes john keegan daily telegraph probably the most important revisionist text to be published since the war alan clark the times

clementine lady spencer churchill died in 1977 aged 92 though she was in the limelight throughout her adult life comparatively little is known about her for she shunned publicity her youngest daughter mary has written this major biography with affection and candour revealing a gift for vivid and precise phrase that might be expected of winston churchill s daughter clementine churchill was the perfect wife for winston for 57 years she supported him through the triumphs disasters and tensions which ruled his public and private life as a young girl she had known the unhappiness that came from ill matched parents and continual shortage of money but she had a strength of character and distinction of mind allied to the outstanding good looks that attracted the young and impetuous winston churchill his

courtship was swift and clementine became the wife of the mp for dundee in september 1908 the early years of her marriage coincided with the heyday of the reforming liberal government in which the winston was a leading figure she was later to describe them as the happiest of her life always winston trusted her completely and she became a valuable counsellor and companion he invariably wanted her opinion but did not always take her advice she believed in him passionately and in his destiny standing beside him in public seemingly serene cool and detached the public persona however was dearly bought in truth clementine was shy passionate and highly strung and her self control was tested to the utmost in the turmoil of public life in the no less harrowing family crises and the ever present financial anxieties but shakespeare s line about the love that looks on tempests and is never shaken could have been written about this lion hearted couple and their joint correspondence is not only of historic interest but is deeply moving lady soames s description of her mother s steadfast bearing sir winston s funeral is unforgettable before she went to bed that night she turned to her daughter and said you know mary it wasn t a funeral it was a triumph in its own way clementine churchill s life was a triumph too publisher
