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many higher education institutions are like small towns meeting the needs of their members by providing not only specialist teaching and research

activities but also residential accommodation catering telecommunications counselling sports facilities and so on the management of these institutions is very complex requiring both generalist and specialist knowledge and skills and the move to formal strategic planning means that it is no longer acceptable for higher education managers to be aware only of their own relatively narrow areas of expertise all new managers would benefit from an holistic perspective on managing a whole institution as such individuals are promoted such helicopter vision becomes a precondition of their and their institution s success higher education management provides the first comprehensive account of non academic higher education management contributions from distinguished practitioners of university management a key resource for all aspiring trainee and practising managers in higher education

this volume seeks to identify and explore the dynamics of global forces on the development of higher education in asia in particular how neoliberalism has affected reforms on university governance and management in the region it includes a set of country specific studies on how various countries have responded to the dominant neoliberal ideology at the systemic institutional and process levels the focus is on the relationship between the state and the universities which is usually reflected in the degree of autonomy and accountability allowed in a particular higher education system the selected countries are cambodia china indonesia india japan malaysia singapore south korea and thailand each case study examines the establishment of corporatised or autonomous universities in the country focusing on i the acts reports and or policies that led to such a move as well as the rationales behind the move ii the changes in the governance and organisational structure of the universities highlighting the kinds of autonomy that the universities have iii the new management strategies techniques and practices that have been introduced to the university including the internal and external quality assurance mechanisms and iv some of the tensions conflicts and acts of resistance that may have emerged

this book provides an alternative means of discussing the development and significance of managers and management in universities and colleges it is particularly concerned with the way managing involves the development of different ways of talking acting and relating to people at work yet this is often difficult and variably successful as it confronts often strong professional and occupational work identities and cultures the book provides a detailed look at the manager in contemporary further and higher education in britain as post compulsory education has been required to operate on a more commercial basis and universities and colleges are increasingly regarded as small to medium sized enterprises it draws upon interviews with more than 70 senior post holders it explores for example the work of the traditional university vice chancellor who came to see himself as the new chief executive schooled himself in the works of international management gurus henry mintzberg and tom peters and engaged his 3000 staff in the virtues of thriving on chaos the result as one seasoned higher education observer has noted was 18 months of misery for university personnel it tells the story of the professor of material science who came to see himself as small businessman responsible for

maintaining a 2 million a year departmental turnover but at the same time he considered this new identity to be constantly hamstrung by the bureaucratic centralism of his university it tells the stories of senior women administrators who empowered by their appointment as managers challenged the deeply embedded paternalism of their senior academic colleagues and it tells the stories of numerous heads of department and sections repositioned as managers in the new marketized further education who have struggled to re imagine students as funding units and colleagues as their staff craig prichard provides a highly nuanced theoretically sophisticated and critically informed account of the repositioning of senior university and college academics as managers this is important reading for those interested in post compulsory education public sector management and the sociology of work and education and of course for university and college managers themselves

the nature of higher education in the uk has changed over the last three decades academics can no longer be said to carry out their work in ivory towers as increasing government intervention and a growing target culture has changed the way they work increasingly universities have transformed from communities of scholars to workplaces the organization and administration of universities has seen a corresponding prevalence of ideas and strategies drawn from the new public management ideology in response promoting a more business focussed approach in the management of public services this book examines the issues that these changes have had on academics both as the knowledge workers managed and the manager academic it draws on a detailed study of academics holding management roles ranging from head of department to vice chancellor in sixteen uk universities exploring their career histories and trajectories and providing extensive accounts of their values practices relationships with others and their training and development as managers drawing on debates around new public management knowledge management and knowledge workers the wider implications of these themes for policy innovation and strategy in he and the public sector more generally are considered developing a critical response to recent approaches to managing public services and practical suggestions for improvements which could be made to the training and support of senior and middle managers in universities the book will be of interest to all teaching researching or managing in higher education education policy makers and academics and researchers concerned with public

management knowledge management or higher education

this book asks how modern universities are organized and managed and questions whether 30 years of university reforms have resulted in stronger managerial structures and leadership control it further asks whether current organisational and decision making structures can be explained by public reform policies the book offers a coherent empirically grounded and theoretically driven presentation of data and core ideas behind a large scale comparative study of 26 universities across eight european countries it focuses on the strength of university managerial structures the role of academics and how universities relate to and depend on their environment to governments and other actors to funders to evaluators and to external stakeholders it further explores how higher education policies are shaped by and affect universities written by a cross disciplinary team of european scholars this book is unique both in its wide coverage and the depth of its analyses it will be of great interest to scholars graduate students and advanced undergraduates in the fields of organisation theory and sociology policy studies comparative public policy and administration and higher education studies it will also be of interest to higher education policy makers and administrators

this volume investigates governance and management of higher education through the lens of the academic profession drawing on data from the academic profession in the knowledge based society project an international collaborative research study involving the administration of a common survey to faculty in more than twenty countries this volume explores important issues of governance and management in relation to and frequently from the perspective of the academic profession it analyzes the complex inter relationships and intersections between decision processes and structures at both the system and institutional levels and the experiences and perceptions of the academics who play a central role in fulfilling the mission of higher education theoretical chapters review key concepts that have grounded the analysis of external system level and internal institution level governance while the core chapters provide original empirical research many involving comparative studies exploring key challenges such as managerialism gender shifts in faculty perceptions of influence and the importance of communication and institutional leadership chapter 4 10 11 and 12 of this book are available open access under a cc by 4 0 license at [link.springer.com](http://link.springer.com)
