an activist priest provides sanctuary for an encampment of unhoused people in her churchyard the housing crisis plaguing major urban centres has sent countless people into the streets in spring 2022 some of them found their way to the yard beside the anglican church in toronto s kensington market where maggie helwig is the priest they pitched tents formed an encampment and settled in known as an outspoken social justice activist helwig has spent the last three years getting to

know the residents and fighting tooth and nail to allow them to stay battling various authorities that want to clear the yard and keep the results of the housing crisis out of sight and out of mind encampment tells the story of helwig s life long activism as preparation for her fight to keep her churchyard open to people needing a home more importantly it introduces us to the artist to jeff and to robin their lives their challenges their humanity it confronts our society s callousness in allowing so many to go unhoused and demands by bringing their stories to the fore that we begin to respond with compassion and grace

homelessness in america has grown from a minor problem in isolated areas of a few big cities into a near epidemic today scarcely any american city of any appreciable size lacks homeless people homeless shelters and programs have become as essential and as commonplace as police protection or water and sewage treatment what to do for with or about the homeless is a nagging and complex social policy issue debated at all levels of government address unknown emphasizes the large scale social and economic forces that have priced an increasingly large segment of the urban poor completely out of the housing
