Health as Thomas Ærvold bjerre and Beata Zawadka note in their introduction, the so-called healthy south has never been an easy topic for scholars dealing with the region. One reason for this is that researchers have been taught to approach so formulated a topic no further than to the point when it turns out it is a contradiction in terms and indeed there is much in southern history and the present situation that justifies such an approach. This volume however comprises a collective effort of southernist historians, literature experts and culture critics to transcend the contradictory concept of the healthy south and does so by reinventing the notion of the southern disease and consequently the role of the south as a scourge in American culture in terms of this culture's bountiful gift.
