the title expresses the book's intention not to go on distinguishing between god and the world so as then to surrender the world as godless to its scientific disenchantment and its technical exploitation by human beings but instead to discover god in all the beings he has created and to find his life giving spirit in the community of creation that they share this view which has also been called panentheistic in contrast to pantheistic requires us to bring reverence for the life of every living thing into the adoration of god and this means expanding the worship and service of god to include service for god's creation

biblical creation faith and biblical salvation faith both have important statements regarding creation theology karl lönning and erich zenger bring the parts of the divided yet unified christian bible into dialogue with one another so that the entire biblical tradition attains a new life

in keeping with the scriptural witness and the theological heritage creation and new creation examines the doctrine of creation alongside new creation the connection between the two creation and new creation has drawn renewed attention in the last several decades but the burden of sean mcdonough s argument is that this emphasis on creation and new creation has been a feature of the doctrine since the beginning whether in the eschatological reading of genesis 1 that predominated at least until early modern times or the intertwining of the narratives of creation and redemption in thinkers from early church father irenaeus to modern theologian karl barth while covering the traditional elements of the doctrine mcdonough treats this important subject with a special emphasis on how these unfold in the story of what colin gunton has called god s creation project

worthing describes the critique of traditional arguments for god s existence by physicists he then examines three christian doctrines in light of theoretical physics god and creation out of nothing in relation to the big bang theory god and continuing creation in relation to field theory bell s theorem providence entropy and theodicy and god and the consummation of creation

if we pick up the bible as god s word and at the beginning read with trepidation then the whole of the bible is so read this book was written to help christians navigate some of the forces of modernity which have crept into the church and influenced the way christians view the reliability of the biblical creation account and more generally the bible its purpose is to encourage readers to see the steadfastness of god s word as a way of making sense of our lives and the world we live in it hopes to show that a faith based historical reading of gen 1 3 provides a more trustworthy explanation of reality than atheistic evolutionary theories or reading the genesis story as a make believe myth but the book is not a polemic per se it proposes a faith based historical reading of the creation story in hopes of learning more about god creation and ourselves
