provide industry insights to students this volume fills that gap it has twenty indian cases related to different aspects of business management the cases cover some of the prominent disciplines of management like marketing finance human resource management strategy management operations management accounting and mergers and acquisitions these cases best serve the purpose of adoption of case methodology in classroom teaching or online lecture sessions for the faculty and students of business management
