residents faith based and nonprofit groups stepped in to rebuild compelled by the moral pull of charity and the emotional rewards of volunteer labor adams traces the success of charity efforts even while noting an irony of neoliberalism which encourages the very same for profit companies to exploit these charities as another market opportunity in so doing the companies profit not once but twice on disaster
