Figures of Simplicity explores a unique constellation of figures from philosophy and literature Heinrich von Kleist Herman Melville G W Leibniz and Alexander Baumgarten in an attempt to recover alternative conceptions of aesthetics and dimensions of thinking lost in the disciplinary narration of aesthetics after Kant this is done primarily by tracing a variety of simpletons that populate the writings of Kleist and Melville these figures are not entirely ignorant or stupid but simple their simplicity is a way of thinking one that author Birgit Mara Kaiser here suggests is affective thinking Kaiser avers that Kleist and Melville are experimenting in their texts with an affective mode of thinking and thereby continue she argues a key line within eighteenth century aesthetics the relation of rationality and sensibility through her analyses she offers an outline of what thinking can look like if we take affectivity into account

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appealing to readers of delia owens where the crawdads sing kristin hannah s firefly lane and ann packer s the dive from clausen s pier belonging is a heartbreaking and hopeful coming of age story that traverses lifelong friendship first love and a young woman s fierce desire to transcend her traumatic childhood jenny is thirteen when an epic dust storm rolls into her central california town in december 1977 bedridden after contracting a life threatening illness in the storm and suffering a shocking loss jenny realizes she will never be cared for by the mother who both neglects and terrifies her or the father who allows it she relies on her cousin heather who has the loving home jenny longs for her beloved great uncle gino the last link between generations her best friend henry a free spirit with whom she shares an inexplicable bond and earnest baseball star billy who becomes her first love after a stunning turn of events in both their lives jenny and henry leave for college in la together in the summer of 1982 jenny fleeing a broken heart and henry running from something he can t reveal even to his best friend when she returns home years later the life jenny so carefully created collides with the one she left behind spanning three decades belonging is about first love and heartbreak friendship and secrets family and forgiveness hometowns and coming of age and memory and music the heart of the story is jenny s struggle to undo the binds of a childhood that have deeply affected her life the painful path to love endured by children raised in alcoholic families and the grim reality of believing you must hide a part of yourself in order to belong

at the rainbow s end is about the lives of jefferson and mary bright plantation owners about their struggles and the struggles of recently freed slaves to survive in a newly ordered society lurking in the background is the ku klux klan who kill and threaten all who would oppose them in a desperate effort to restore the old order an insurgency that fosters among other things jealousy and murder and events that threaten jefferson and mary with more than the loss of a way of life

violet never wanted to move to perfect who wants to live in a town where everyone has to wear glasses to stop them going blind and who wants to be neat and tidy and perfectly behaved all the time but violet quickly discovers there s something weird going on in the town she keeps hearing voices her mam is acting strange and her dad has disappeared when she meets boy she realizes that her dad is not the only person to have vanished and that the mysterious watchers are guarding a perfectly creepy secret

set against a backdrop of suburban arkansas in the simpler bygone era of the 1980s when souls come together is a charming novel that portrays the magic innocence and discovery of falling in love for the first time molly horner is a sensitive and shy girl of 14 a plainly pretty brunette whose family has constantly been relocating from one town to the next since her mother died although molly is sad to say goodbye to her best friend for the family s latest move when she winds up in hope arkansas she s pleasantly surprised to find it s not so bad but when molly meets billy hunt a down to earth 16 year old rocker her life is turned upside down by feelings she s never experienced before with new friends a new house and new love in her life for the first time hope may just

turn out to be the light at the end of the tunnel molly has been looking for about the author although when souls come together is her first novel mary e pulido has been writing poems and short stories for more than twenty years having grown up as a military brat and moving from town to town during her high school years the author was able to draw on her own real life experiences for this book a married mother of three when she is not working mary also runs a restaurant with her husband in the town of rice texas where she has lived for the past 16 years publisher s website sbpra com maryepulido
