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nadya aisenberg discusses the potentialities of the crime novel its implications principles and scope and its analogy of myth and the fairy tale she proposes that the detective story and the thriller have made an unacknowledged contribution to serious literature her discussion of dickens conrad and green indicate that each borrowed many important ingredients from the formulaic novel

as every detective novel addict knows there s no greater high than figuring out whodunit before the final revelation resulting in the kind of intellectual satisfaction a shot of bourbon can never offer dove takes this reader writer play to a new level by critically assessing the genre through the principles of reader response theory outlining the detective story as a special case of reading governed by rules and a specialized formula that traces its genealogy back to poe s the murders in the rue

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since their inception detective novels have been a wildly successful genre of american fiction featuring a uniquely american belief in rugged individualism this book focuses on raymond chandler s creation of philip marlowe a detective whose feeling for community and willingness to compromise radically changed the genre s vigilantism and violence it compares chandler s work to early and mid 20th century american detective novels particularly those by john carroll daly mickey spillane dashiell hammett and ross macdonald as well as contemporary british detective fiction highlighting chandler s contribution to the american genre

nominated 2024 edgar allan poe award in the category of best critical biographical mystery writers of america shortlisted 2024 agatha awards best mystery nonfiction malice domestic posthumous winner 2023 ifca book prize international crime fiction association narrative innovation is typically seen as the domain of the avant garde however techniques such as nonlinear timelines multiple points of view and unreliable narration have long been part of american popular culture how did forms and styles once regarded as difficult become familiar to audiences in perplexing plots david bordwell reveals how crime fiction plays and films made unconventional narrative mainstream he shows that since the nineteenth century detective stories and suspense thrillers have allowed ambitious storytellers to experiment with narrative tales of crime and mystery became a training ground where audiences learned to appreciate artifice these genres demand a sophisticated awareness of storytelling conventions they play games with narrative form and toy with audience expectations bordwell examines how writers and directors have pushed pulled and collaborated with their audiences to change popular storytelling he explores the plot engineering of figures such as raymond chandler agatha christie dashiell hammett patricia highsmith alfred hitchcock dorothy sayers and quentin tarantino and traces how mainstream storytellers and modernist experimenters influenced one another s work a sweeping kaleidoscopic account written in a lively conversational style perplexing plots offers an ambitious new understanding of how movies literature theater and popular culture have evolved over the past century

in this first general theory for the analysis of popular literary formulas john g cawelti reveals the artistry that underlies the best in formulaic literature cawelti discusses such seemingly diverse works as mario puzo s the godfather dorothy sayers s the nine tailors and owen wister s the virginian in the light of his hypotheses about the cultural function of formula literature he describes the most important artistic characteristics of popular formula stories and the differences between this literature and that commonly labeled high or serious literature he also defines the archetypal patterns of adventure mystery romance melodrama and fantasy and offers a tentative account of their basis in human psychology

this is a prose series of unpublished interviews with and a visual retrospective of the seminal mid to late 20th century literary crime writer in 1976 critic paul nelson

spent several weeks interviewing legendary detective writer ross macdonald who elevated the form to a new literary level we talked about everything imaginable nelson wrote including macdonald s often meager beginnings his dual citizenship writers painters music and movies he admired the great gatsby his favorite book how he used symbolism to change detective writing and more this book published in a handsome oversized format collects these unpublished interviews and is a visual history of macdonald s professional career it is illustrated with rare and select items from one of the world s largest private archives of macdonald ephemera reproduces in full color the covers of the various editions of macdonald s more than two dozen books collects facsimile reproductions of select pages from his manuscripts as well as magazine spreads and presents rare photos many never before seen

presents a pictorial history of magazine periodical and book illustration of mystery and detective stories featuring the work of both well known and anonymous artists

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now in the fatal art of entertainment interviews with mystery writers herbert provides answers in a volume that will introduce anyone from the literary scholar to the mystery fan to the talented calculating and witty minds that commit murder on the printed page much to the entertainment and fascination of millions of readers in a unique collection of interviews herbert provides three types of portraits of each of thirteen authors a photographic likeness an essay describing each author s personality place in the crime writing genre and the environment of the interview and a conversational visit that enables the reader to feel personally acquainted with each author these revealing interviews with such luminaries as p d james tony hillerman john mortimer sue grafton julian symons and patricia d

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
