one of the most dramatic events in sea history was the scuttling of the german high seas fleet six months after the end of the first world war witnessed in its entirety by only a few people the great scuttle took place in a remote corner of the british isles which most of us scarcely know by name yet in the immensity of the project and its international repercussions it shook the world and put scapa flow on everyone s lips from dustjacket

the naval anchorage of scapa flow is the resting place of many wrecks including several from the german grand fleet

a new look at the naval base at scapa flow orkney and the ships that have used it and still remain today

scapa flow a vast natural harbour in the orkney islands served as the royal navy s main base during the two world wars from where ships sailed to the battle of jutland in the first and in convoy to northern russia in the second thousands of men and women saw service in and around this remote anchorage including soldiers and sailors who crewed the ships and manned the lonely batteries and wrens nurses and civilians who were posted there scapa flow brings together their memories the bleak isolation its implacable winds and glorious sunsets the camaraderie and good humour forming a compelling portrait of a unique war station that left its mark on all who served there

on the night of 13 14 october 1939 the german commander of u boat u 47 günther prien steered past the sunken block ships and chains which inadequately protected the british naval base at scapa flow in the orkney islands the u boat sank the old british world war i battleship hms royal oak and then escaped into the north sea the loss of the royal oak was insignificant in naval terms though over 800 men perished with her however this was a bitter blow to british moral

## the bull and the barriers

reminds us of the courage and immense sacrifices made by orcadians and tells of the efforts made by the british to protect their remote islanders superb books monthly orkney was a key strategic location during the second world war the vast anchorage of scapa flow was the main haven for the royal navy s home fleet making it a prime target for the luftwaffe and attempts to bomb the anchorage were made from the beginning of the war in the early hours of 14 october 1940 a german submarine apparently penetrated scapa flow s defenses and managed to sink the aging battleship hms royal oak with the loss of 834 of her crew including many boy sailors the loss spurred changes to the defenses of scapa flow which hugely impacted orkney orcadians also made a huge contribution to the war effort through farming and in providing support to the thousands of sailors soldiers and airmen who were based locally orcadians also raised considerable funds and gathered much needed items including scrap metal and even sphagnum moss for use in the treatment of wounds large numbers of orcadians worked in the fishing industry and this was a staple supplier of food for the islands as well as a key employer the men aboard the trawlers were used to danger but the war ramped this up even further as many became prey to german attacks from the air although isolated from the mainland the people of orkney made a very substantial contribution to the war effort and many paid the ultimate price losing their lives in the service of their country another beautiful volume for the series on the old barbed wire

scapa flow was one of the world's great naval bases and the scene of many of the major events of twentieth century naval history during both world wars the royal navy made scapa the home for its capital ships and thousands of servicemen and women were posted to orkney from here the grand fleet sailed for jutland in 1916 from here the escorts for the russian convoys set off and it was in this beautiful bleak anchorage that the german high seas fleet committed the greatest act of suicide ever seen at sea the grand scuttle before being later raised and scrapped in the most astonishing feat of maritime salvage in history it was also in scapa that the last photographs of kitchener were taken as he boarded hms hampshire shortly before she was sunk by mine off marwick head scapa is also the grave of many who fought for their country in both world wars in its silent waters lie the wrecks of the battleship vanguard blown apart by an explosion in 1917 and the royal oak sunk by u 47 in a spectacular raid at the beginning of world war ii here the first luftwaffe raids on britain occured here too italian prisoners of war built both the spectacular churchill causeways and the exquisite chapel on the island of lamb holm in this book illustrated with over 130 archive photographs james miller traces the story of this remarkable place weaving together history eyewitness accounts and personal experience to capture the life and spirit of scapa flow when it was home to thousands of service personnel and the most powerful fleet in the world
