henry friedlander explores in chilling detail how the nazi program of secretly exterminating the handicapped and disabled evolved into the systematic destruction of jews and gypsies tracing the rise of racist and eugenic ideologies in germany he describes how the so called euthanasia of the handicapped provided a practical model for mass murder thereby initiating the holocaust based on extensive research in american german and austrian archives as well as allied and german court records the book also analyzes the involvement of the german bureaucracy and judiciary the participation of physicians and scientists the motives of the killers and the nature of popular opposition friedlander also sheds light on the special plight of handicapped jews who were the first singled out for murder

this study traces the evolution of imperialist ideology in germany from bismarck in the mid 19th century through hitler and the third reich although much has been written about the virulently racist and anti communist ideologies of the nazi party this is the first book to treat nazi imperialism as a separate ideology and set it within a sturdy theoretical framework smith contends that nazi imperialism represented the last ambitious attempt to integrate two century old ideologies the elite pro industrial weltpolitik and the popular based pro agrarian lebensraum into a single system in fact smith argues that it was largely the way in which the nazis attempted to reconcile these contradictory ideologies that explains germany s disastrous policies during world war ii this wide ranging study also contributes to the debates over several other aspects of german history including german military aims in world war ii the continuity or discontinuity of german policy from bismarck to hitler and the relation between ideology and social political life

detlef mohlberger s work hitler s voice the völkischer beobachter 1920 1933 is an important addition to the study of national socialism in today s scholarship it is difficult to

locate a detailed work on national socialism that does not rely in some way on the *völkischer beobachter* it was truly the bullhorn of the party from the time when the national socialists were no more than a small group of unknowns gathering at the munich *bürgerbräukeller* until they gained power in 1933 considering the vast amount of literature on national socialism however it is surprising that until now there have only been shorter articles and two dissertations and not a single comprehensive analysis of the newspaper 1 mohlberger's translation of articles from the *völkischer beobachter* addresses this lacuna he has sifted through eleven years of the paper condensing them into two volumes his first volume gives a chronological account of the development and organization of the party until 1933 while the shorter second volume entitled *nazi ideology and propaganda* examines topical issues such as attacks against the weimar republic racism and attempts by the party to garner support from workers farmers and the german *mittelstand*

james tent recounts how these men and women from all over germany and from all walks of life struggled to survive in an increasingly hostile society even as their jewish relatives were disappearing into the east it draws on extensive interviews with twenty survivors many of whom were teenagers when hitler came to power to show how half jews coped with conditions on a day to day basis and how the legacy of the hatred they suffered still lingers in their minds
