our lord invites us to meditate continuously on the last 24 hours that he suffered during the course of his passion beginning with the moment when he said goodbye to his mother that is before instituting the eucharist and ending with the moment when jesus was buried in every hour of his passion our lord invites us to accompany him and bring him consolation with our love this way little by little as we enter into every scene every word every truth and every suffering we will begin to understand just how great the love of god has been for us and it will be impossible for us not to desire to love him as much he deserves to be loved by us
