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a guide to the identification and natural history of the sparrows of the united states and canada provides comprehensive information on all the features that make possible identification of all 62 species of sparrows that occur in north america the text gives detailed descriptions of the summer winter and juvenile plumages of each species as well as comparisons with similar species the species accounts are illustrated with range maps and superb line drawings showing behavioral postures and where useful fine features of tail feather patterns the 27 color plates splendidly illustrate the various plumages of each species with the emphasis on the distinctive appearance of birds of different sex age and geographic regions this beautiful and authoritative book is a must for the library of all keen birders living in and visiting north america species accounts include discussions of species identification measurements voice habitat ecology nesting biology distribution taxonomy geographic variations historical and present status

this technical and well illustrated guide for archaeologists and conservators aims to provide a methodology for the identification of the woody taxa used to manufacture artefacts recovered from archaeological excavations to provide the anatomical descriptions of the taxa and to present a list of characters of the taxa the guide is heavily illustrated with photographs maps and tables to allow easy identification

the question whether and how boundaries might individuate and thereby be constitutive features of any imaginable legal order has yet to be addressed in a systematic and comprehensive manner by legal and political theory this book seeks to address this important omission providing an original contribution to the debate about law in a global setting against the widely endorsed assumption that we are now moving towards law without boundaries it argues that every imaginable legal order global or otherwise is bounded in space time membership and content the book is built up around three main insights firstly that legal orders can best be understood as a form of joint action in which authorities mediate and uphold who ought to do what where and when with a view to realising the normative point of acting together secondly that behaviour can call into question the boundaries that determine who ought to do what where and when a legality thirdly that this a legality reveals boundaries as marking a limit and to a lesser or greater extent a fault line of the respective legal order legal boundaries reveal ways of ordering the who what where and when of behaviour which have been excluded yet which remain within the range of practical possibilities accessible to the collective limits however legal boundaries also intimate an order which exceeds the range of possibilities accessible to that collective the fault line of the respective legal order careful analysis of a wide range of legal orders including nomadism roman law classical international law ius gentium multinationals cyberlaw lex mercatoria the eu global regimes of

human rights and space law validates this thesis what sense then can we make of the normativity of the law if there can be no inclusion without exclusion arguing that legal and political theories misunderstand how legal boundaries do their work of including and excluding the book develops a normative theory of legal order which is alternative to both communitarianism and cosmopolitanism

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
