last walk completed chapter two returns to the beginning with a naïve walker setting out on the first stage of the north downs way from farnham to guildford on a wet and travel disrupted day in early november that chapter finishes five months later on a bright but windy spring day along the cliff tops into dover proving that you can indeed complete a long distance path in day trips five more routes are covered the ridgeway icknield way path the chiltern way greensand way and the hertfordshire way some walks were interrupted by the covid 19 pandemic or the onset of winter when the days were too short to complete their further reaches but all were eventually finished a thousand miles of walking recalled in a diary entry format each outing is dated and the location and mileage given
