their alleged assassins it places the infamous event at the carthage jail 1846 and the
subsequent murder conspiracy trial in the context of mormon and american legal history
and deals with the question of achieving justice when crimes are politically motivated
and popularly supported

or noun people like Joseph Smith are rich and complex different people saw him differently or focused on a different facet of his personality at different times inescapably what they observed or found out about him was refracted through the lens of their own experience some of the different flickering not always compatible views are the subject of this book Davis Bitton Davis Bitton's life was cut short before he could finish revisions on this collection of insightful essays about Joseph Smith a prophet whom he also considers a hero in both classical terms and the context of nineteenth-century America knowing Brother Joseph again explores images of Joseph Smith from both the devotion of believers and the hostility and skepticism of opponents
