first published in 1996 this book summarises the seminar held in edinburgh in 1994 in the five hundredth year since the publication of luca pacioli s *summa de arithmeticā geometriā proportioni et proportionalitā* its purpose is simple but relevant to every accountant it revisits some fundamentals that lay behind pacioli s decision to write his *summa* and examines whether the accounting framework in which we work today has overlooked basic issues because of its continued focus on development of the existing financial accounting model it analyses pacioli s legacy from several different perspectives deliberately choosing to do so in ways that addressed considerations that his work reflected examining the nature and characteristics of the bridge between academic analysis and insight on the one hand and practical application on the other it also looks at the dominant influences in the evolution of accountancy for managing stewardship and for reporting of that stewardship by doing so it attempts to identify influences that had been less pressing and so had been ignored or overlooked and also considers how changing technology has affected the way we manage the accountancy process

this book first published in 1986 is a celebration of scottish accounting influence and tradition the essays are critical contributions to the study of accounting history split into two main

sections the development of accounting thought and practice prior to the emergence of a regulated accountancy profession and the problems faced in the first 70 years of the accountancy profession

in the last twenty years accounting history literature has been enriched by the widened examination of historical events from different paradigmatic perspectives these debates have typically pitted traditional historians against critical historians the 47 articles in this three volume set delineate the basic tenets of these rival paradigms they include the work of prominent scholars from both camps

this paper contributes to the growing history of accounting history by analysing the contents of all papers published in accounting history one among the leading journals of the field through a recent and promising analytical technique called topic modeling based on literature we know what accounting history is about but we know less how the accounting history field has evolved by adopting topic modeling an automated procedure for coding the content of corpus of text based on bayesian statistic the paper complements prior assessments of the accounting history literature by providing accurate measures about the relative prevalence of research areas and their evolution over time the analysis highlights three sets of topics not uncovered by previous categorizations in particular the regulation topic that refers to international accounting standards and auditing regulation appears to be overlooked by previous reviews in terms of dynamics we find that the technical core of accounting decreased in importance overtime in favour of more variegated and fragmented foci of research this finding may substantiate the claimed shift from a conception of

accounting as a technical practice to the one of accounting as a social practice that is the transition from the so called traditional to new accounting history moreover we see a pluralisation in the range of issues that are under the lenses of accounting historians finally our analysis suggests that the way in which accounting history is presented or talked about has not changed much in the last 20 years

the critical tradition in accounting historiography has come to occupy a prominent place in the discipline s academic scholarship some critical literature has confronted the responsibility of accounting and accountants in precipitating contemporary crises such as the audit failures that spawned sarbanes oxley and the world wide recession certain contemporary issues have long histories such as the difficulties encountered by women to break the glass ceiling in public accounting and the suffering of indigenous peoples under the imperialistic yoke other episodes in accounting s long history are seemingly more divorced from the present but in reality they all have contemporary significance slavery in the new world for example although abolished more than a century ago is still rampant in parts of the world albeit less formally critical accounting historians feel it a duty to harken to the suppressed voices of the past those groups of people who had no access to an accounting record women persons of color indigenous populations alienated proletarians victims of governmental incompetence and graft and many voiceless others critical histories of accounting sinister inscriptions in the modern era draws on the foremost work in this developing literature both that authored by the co editors of this volume and that written by others editors richard k fleischman warwick n funnell and steve walker have written extensively about the dark side of accounting gauging the complicity of those performing accounting functions in episodes in human history that are at worst evil and at best reprehensible the editors have also hand selected a series of historical and contemporary episodes that have been critically investigated by the wider accounting history community preceded by a thorough introduction

there is growing interest in the history of accounting amongst both accounting practitioners and accounting academics this interest developed steadily from about 1970 and really took off in the 1990s however there is a lack of texts dealing with major aspects of accounting history that can be used in classrooms to inform new researchers and to provide a source of reference for established researchers the great deal of research into cost and management accounting in britain published in academic journals over the last twenty years including the authors own contributions makes the history of cost and management accounting an essential contribution to the field
