this book is a treatment of shi a islam from the emic or inside perspective of shi a islam itself as opposed to the perspective of orientalism or of comparative religion or sociology or some other branch of the humanities with their modern western perspectives all of which are philosophical approaches in the sense that they have philosophical rather than religious underpinnings and therefore do not strictly speaking deal with the religion itself as it is understood by the clerisy of its practitioners but do so from a perspective and ideological framework that is alien and indeed antithetical and at times hostile to it the true origins and teachings of shi a islam is perhaps the first major work which is a single volume treatment of the religion of shi a islam as such which approaches the subject not only from an insider s perspective but one that is also comparative comparing and contrasting the origins and teachings of shi a islam with that of the mainstream or
