Stanley Hauerwas begins this volume with a vigorous response to the charge of sectarianism leveled against his work by James Gustafson among others. Show me where I am wrong about God, Jesus, the limits of liberalism, the nature of the virtues or the doctrine of the church. Hauerwas replies to his critics but does not shortcut that task by calling me a sectarian. The essays that follow explore in a lucid, compelling, firm, and provocative way the church's nature, message, and ministry in the world. Hauerwas writes on the church as God's new language, on clerical character, on the pastor as prophet, on the ministry of the local congregation, on grace and public virtue, and on the relation of church and university. Underlying Hauerwas's argument is his conviction that the most important knowledge Christians have no special claim requires a transformation of the self. Christianity is no world view, not a form of primitive metaphysics that can be assessed in comparison to alternative world views. Rather, Christians are people who remain convinced that the truthfulness of their beliefs must be demonstrated in their lives. There is a sense in which Christian convictions are self-referential, but the reference is not to propositions but to lives.

This important contribution to American ecumenism is an impassioned plea for an encounter between the mainline denominational churches and the vital new third force of the evangelical and free churches. It strives to bridge the gulf between the most uncritical supporters of organic church union and those most suspicious of its organizational purpose and theology. It suggests that the common elements of the New Testament church life in all local churches provide a basis for understandings out of which a new spirit and a broad new alignment can evolve. It urges the mainline groups to achieve an understanding with these free churches whose doctrine of authority posits a direct personal rule of Christ over each local gathered congregation without the mediation of bishops, priests, synods, or councils. In seeking a new basis for achieving the reality of the great church coming, which is the ecumenical hope, the author's conviction is that the future of the church in America and of any vital ecumenical witness rests with these left-out churches and their creative rapprochement with other life of all churches together in an exciting and meaningful mission in which American churches of all traditions can share completely yet without compromise.

Developing Faithful Ministers aims to support the work of all those involved in supervision and training relationships within the church. The church, recognizing its call to serve God and the nation, seeks to equip and develop its ministers to face the challenge of ministry in a society at the threshold of Christendom. That is, in a mission context, it is a context where both the general public and the institutional church have significant expectations of those in ministry. Indeed, there is now an expectation of demonstrable capability prior to being licensed to any form of permanent tenure. The demand for more professional, demonstrably capable, mission-able, and collaborative licensed ministers places particular weight on the efficacy of the initial training relationship. Developing Faithful Ministers seeks to support those who find themselves in these relationships by offering both models of good practice and sustained theological reflection on what these drivers mean for developing ministry.
