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sentence craft is a text workbook which presents in close correlation a discussion of the practice and theory of writing mature sentences and extensive exercise material to implement this instruction although the book has been planned primarily for the freshman course in composition it can be used effectively at any college level for it has been written to assist students to develop helpful techniques for securing order and design as they learn to write progressively more mature sentence
