chinese narrative poetry brings a new perspective to some of china s best loved and most influential poems including ts ai yen s poem of affliction po chu yi s song of everlasting sorrow and wei chuang s recently discovered song of the lady of ch in composed in the shih form during the late han six dynasties and t ang periods these poems stand out as masterworks of narrative art yet paradoxically their narrative qualities have been little recognized or explored in either traditional chinese or modern

western scholarship the reason for this neglect is that western literary traditions acknowledge their origins in epic poetry and thus take narrative for granted but the chinese tradition is fundamentally based on lyric and does not admit of a separate category for narrative poetry drawing on both classical chinese critical works and the most recent western contributions to the theory of narrative levy shows how narrative elements developed out of the lyrical conventions of shih in doing so she accomplishes a double purpose guiding the modern reader to an understanding of the nature of narrative in chinese poetry and shedding light on the ways in which chinese poets adapted the devices of lyric to the needs of a completely different expressive mode students of chinese literature will welcome this pathbreaking study but chinese narrative poetry will interest other scholars as well because it addresses questions of crucial importance for literary theory and comparative literature particularly the central issue of the applicability of western critical concepts to non western literature and culture

this volume follows on from the first in the series where a selection of classical chinese poems well known to all chinese school children was presented in a form easy for overseas students of the chinese language to assimilate here we continue with a further selection of popular chinese classics chosen for the insight they provide on chinese history and culture part 1 looks at history through the eyes of some of the poets of the tang dynasty who reference the heroes of ancient battles of the three kingdoms period as well as expressing the dashed hopes and aspirations of those caught up in the current struggles against barbarians from the north we even hear about the founder of the qin dynasty and his final battle giving way to the establishment of the han the importance of geography in these struggles is not forgotten and we see how the yellow river was the cradle of the chinese civilization and the yangtse the barrier separating the three kingdoms as well as the major thoroughfare transporting li bai from exile to rehabilitation two other major strategic features are discussed the great wall defending the trade route the old silk road and the grand canal alleviating the threat of flood and transporting supplies throughout the country and playing a key rôle in its prosperity in part 2 we look at the culture of ancient china and although most of the poets quoted here lived in the tang and song eras their works draw heavily on influences from the past we see women in different guises as workers cultivating silk worms to their role as concubines the delights and perils of that occupation and ending with the sending away of a young girl to an arranged marriage we look at the imperial examination system a key factor in maintaining governance of the empire over two thousand years also examined is the expression of dissidence in the political system of social waywardness and debauchery and the moral character instilled in different ways with the three major religions or philosophies of china daoist confucian and

buddhist finally a number of chinese poems have made their way to the west in translation and we go back and look at the sources for a couple of these poems while an assortment of thirty odd tang dynasty poems is clearly just skimming the surface of the wealth of chinese poetry in existence the aim by finding poems which link to aspects of chinese culture is to provide as varied a collection as possible making the reading of these poems more accessible and their study more rewarding

poetry has always been held in high regard in china as it can provide expressions of deep emotion offering insight into the inner life of chinese writers across space and time chinese poetry often reflects the influence of its various religious traditions this collection contains 81 carefully selected chinese poems arranged in chronological order from classical periods c 2000 bce to modern times 1972 although most of them are from the tang 618 907 and song 960 1279 dynasties as these two periods were the climax of chinese poetry creation and development the selection is based on the popularity of the poems from which common phrases are taken for everyday chinese language pinyin has been added to help readers learn mandarin while reading them and feel the sense of poetics in them during the translation it was found interesting and surprising that certain rhythms in the classical chinese poems were able to be translated to follow certain rhythms in english maybe there is a universal truth about composing poetry this bilingual edition with original chinese text and pinyin pronunciation may help western readers learn the chinese language while reading the english translation
