an immensely popular genre crime fiction has only in recent years been engaged significantly by african american authors historically the racist stereotypes often central to crime fiction and the socially conservative nature of the genre presented problems for writing the black experience and the tropes of justice and restoration of social order have not resonated with authors who saw social justice as a work in progress some african american authors did take up the challenge pauline hopkins rudolph fisher and chester himes led the way in the first half of the 20th century followed by ishmael reed s anti detective novels in the 1970s since the 1990s walter mosley colson whitehead and stephen l carter have written detective fiction focusing on questions of constitutional law civil rights biological and medical issues education popular culture the criminal justice system and matters of social justice from hopkins s hagar s daughter published in 1901 to hime s hardboiled harlem detective series to carter s patrician world of the black bourgeoisie these authors provide a means of examining literary and social constructions of the african american experience instructors considering this book for use in a course may request an examination copy here

history he tells how young men were socialized to the values of the northeastern establishment in those years before world war ii and how as a non practicing jew he learned to overcome bigotry both at andover and at harvard which then had no jewish professors in 1957 blum joined the faculty of yale university s history department widely regarded as the nation s best where he became both influential and popular and where his students included one future u s president as well as others who aspired to the office he reveals much about the inner workings of ivy league education and tells of controversies over the vietnam war and the black panthers his role in eugene mccarthy s presidential campaign and how he searched for common ground between reactionary faculty and radical students more than a recounting of a singular life blum s story explains how political history was researched and written during the second half of the twentieth century describing how the discipline evolved gained ascendancy and was challenged as historical fashions changed it also offers revealing glimpses of such prominent academics as kingman brewster arthur schlesinger jr c vann woodward and william sloan coffin over a distinguished career blum witnessed considerable change in elite educational institutions where minorities and women were grossly underrepresented when he first entered academia in a memoir brimming with insight and laced with humor he looks back at the academy not a refuge from reality but an alternative reality as he reflects upon his intellectual journey and his contributions to the study and writing of twentieth century american history

in many popular depictions of black resistance to slavery stereotypes around victimization and the heroic efforts of a small number of individuals abound these ideas ignore the powers of ordinary families and obscure the systematic working of racism tending to the past selfhood and culture in children s narratives about slavery and freedom examines black authored historical novels and films for children that counter this distortion and depict creative means by which ordinary african americans survived slavery and racism in early america tending to the past argues that this important understudied historical writing freedom narratives calls on young readers to be active critical thinkers about the past and its legacies within the present the book examines how narratives by children s book authors such as joyce hansen julius lester marilyn nelson and patricia mckissack and the filmmakers charles burnett and zeinabu irene davis were influenced by black cultural imperatives such as the black arts movement to foster an engaged culturally aware public through careful analysis of this rich body of work tending to the past thus contributes to ongoing efforts to construct a history of black children s literature and film attuned to its range specificity and depths tending to the past provides illuminating interpretations that will help scholars and educators see the significance of the freedom narratives reconstructions in a neoliberal era a time of shrinking opportunities for many african americans it offers models for understanding the powers and continuing relevance of the black child s creative agency and the black cultural practices that have fostered it
