in 1850 following a divorce and a number of encounters with the law boone helm headed out west to chase the californian gold rush with his cousin when his cousin pulled out at the last minute helm was incensed and brutally stabbed him to death helm was detained in an asylum for the mentally disturbed but managed to escape helm continued his journey west

with renewed vigour where he opportunistically killed and consumed the flesh of adversaries and travelling companions earning him the nickname the kentucky cannibal after several brutal months in the wilderness he finally made it california at a time where violence was the law of the land helm s savage set of skills could finally be recognised and rewarded the kentucky cannibal is a riveting account of boone helm and his bloody exploits across the wild west ryan green s entrancing narrative draws the reader into the real live horror experienced by the victims and has all the elements of a classic thriller caution this book contains descriptive accounts of abuse and violence if you are especially sensitive to this material it might be advisable not to read any further

gold rush fever in the 1860s brought thousands of miners to the new territories of british columbia and the yukon armed with rifles revolvers and bowie knives among them were thugs and outlaws lured by the promise of easy riches within months of the first arrivals a provincial police force was formed the first in western canada and constables recruited to preserve order in the colonies these intrepid lawmen patrolled vast regions of vancouver island the cariboo the kootenays and the klondike they lived in rugged conditions and brought their prisoners by horseback stagecoach or canoe to courtrooms that were often hundreds of kilometers away when no judges were available they evolved their own ways of settling disputes and meting out frontier justice this dramatic collection of stories recounts some of the most notorious cases of the period from boone helm the west s most vicious criminal known for shooting his victims in the back and eating at least one of them to the wild mcleans a gang of adolescent brothers who terrorized the okanagan and nicola valley to the yukon s christmas day assassins whose elaborate plan of escape failed to outsmart the clever watch of the north west mounted police together they offer a vivid profile of outlaw life and the pioneer lawmen who maintained order in a frontier land

a delightfully wicked look at the badly behaved characters who shaped the history of montana through their deeds and

misdeeds

in february 1874 alfred packer staggered out of the colorado mountains and into the los pinos indian agency snowbound and lost he claimed to have been abandoned by his five companions but behind the wilderness grime he looked rather well fed and he had in his possession a skinning knife when questioned packer confessed that four of the group had survived by eating two who had died of exhaustion later he killed another in self defence eating him also packer was arrested on suspicion of murder but escaped that same month the half eaten bodies of five men were discovered near los pinos packer s guilt was assumed but the law did not catch up with him until 1883 initially sentenced to death he received a 40 year jail term paroled in 1901 he lived his last years in denver was packer the flesh eating monster of myth or a wretch who acted out of self preservation maneater tells his story in page turning prose and also reveals how recent forensic developments may shed light on packer s long assumed cannibalism

the recent discovery of the helm family journal coupled with the family s permission to disclose its contents has resulted in the abridged version of this book titled brother levi the book is a century long accurate account of the pioneering helm family both in kentucky and missouri highlighting their most infamous family member one levi boone helm levi boone helm is more commonly known simply as boone helm the kentucky cannibal a true villain of the nineteenth century frontier the book is an unabashed untamed account of boone helm by the two men who knew him best joseph helm iii his eldest brother with input from his uncle james helm the journal paints a stark contrast to the dime store novels or newspaper articles of the day boone helm was indeed extraordinary in terms of fearsome brutality and savage cannibalism thoroughly skilled in methods of murder this man s region of rage extended from the mississippi river to the pacific ocean and from canada into mexico and all parts in between he was not averse to killing strangers men women and children or members of his own family unlike many villains of the era due to the record documented on the pages of the helm family journal boone helm should probably be recognized as the most prolific serial killer in american history bar none i hope the reader will
