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nefertiti s sun temple publishes stone relief fragments excavated from the site of kom el nana at tell el amarna egypt dating to approximately 1350 bce this is the first time relief fragments can be associated with a specific wall from a specific temple at tell el amarna jacquelyn williamson reconstructs the architecture art and inscriptions from the site to demonstrate kom el nana is the location of queen nefertiti s sunshade of re temple and another more enigmatic structure that served the funerary needs of the non royal courtiers at the ancient city the art and inscriptions provide new information about queen nefertiti and challenge assumptions about her role in pharaoh akhenaten s religious movement dedicated to the sun god aten

tell el amarna is the modern name for the ancient egyptian city of akhenaten situated in a bay of hills formed by the cliffs of the eastern desert about halfway between cairo and luxor the city was founded in the 14th century bc by the pharaoh akhenaten to be a royal palace for himself and his wife nefertiti the capital of all egypt and the center of the state cult of the sun god in the form of aten sun disc which became an obsession of the pharaoh the city contained temples palaces state buildings and great private mansions but was abandoned by akhenaten s successor his son tutenkhamen and the city was demolished never to be re inhabited this volume presents a detailed illustrated catalog of the many statues statuettes reliefs inlays and inscriptions recorded

and collected by flinders petrie together with glass and faience objects and moulds part ii provides a summary of developments in royal names and titles with a discussion on research into names and evidence of royal status

a new account of the return to orthodoxy after akhenaten s revolution which combines erudition with expertise to create an exciting account of a much mythologized period book news now in a fully revised paperback amarna sunset tells the story of the decline and fall of the pharaoh akhenaten s religious revolution in the fourteenth century bc beginning at the regime s high point in his year 12 it traces the subsequent collapse that saw the deaths of many of the king s loved ones his attempts to guarantee the revolution through co rulers and the last frenzied assault on the god amun the book then outlines the events of the subsequent five decades that saw the extinction of the royal line an attempt to place a foreigner on egypt s throne and the accession of three army officers in turn among its conclusions are that the mother of tutankhamun was none other than nefertiti and that the queen was joint pharaoh in turn with both her husband akhenaten and her son as such she was herself instrumental in beginning the return to orthodoxy undoing her erstwhile husband s life work before her own mysterious disappearance this fully updated and extensively revised paperback edition addresses new evidence and discussions that have appeared in the decade since the book was originally published amarna sunset together with its recently updated companion volume amarna sunrise accordingly provides readers with a comprehensive up to date overview of egyptian history during the golden years of the late bronze age in the eastern mediterranean and the near east

the move to a new capital akhenaten amarna brought essential changes in the depictions of royal women it was in their female imagery above all that the artists of amarna departed from the traditional iconic representations to emphasize the individual the natural in a way unprecedented in egyptian art

nefertiti one of ancient egypt s most captivating and influential queens remains a figure shrouded in mystery and intrigue her name meaning the beautiful one has come hints at her exotic origins though little is known for certain about her early life some historians believe she was a member of the egyptian nobility possibly the daughter of ay a prominent official others suggest foreign origins potentially linking her to mitanni royalty regardless of her birthplace nefertiti s remarkable journey from obscurity to queenhood is a testament to her enduring legacy nefertiti s life took a dramatic turn when she married amenhotep iv later known as akhenaten their union marked the beginning of one of ancient egypt s most transformative periods as akhenaten s great royal wife nefertiti played a central role in the royal family often depicted alongside her husband in scenes of worship and domestic life their partnership appeared to be one of both love and power as nefertiti is shown participating actively in religious ceremonies and royal duties signifying her status as more than just a consort upon ascending to the throne akhenaten and nefertiti initiated radical religious changes abandoning traditional polytheism in favor of the monotheistic worship of aten the sun disk this religious revolution known as the amarna period saw the couple establish a new capital akhetaten modern day amarna nefertiti s involvement in this spiritual shift was profound as she was frequently depicted alongside akhenaten

worshiping aten with equal devotion she became a symbol of the new religious order embodying divine femininity and royal authority

egypt's sun queen magnificently revealed in a new book by renowned egyptologist aidan dodson during the last half of the fourteenth century bc egypt was perhaps at the height of its prosperity it was against this background that the amarna revolution occurred throughout its instigator king akhenaten had at his side his great wife nefertiti when a painted bust of the queen found at amarna in 1912 was first revealed to the public in the 1920s it soon became one of the great artistic icons of the world nefertiti's name and face are perhaps the best known of any royal woman of ancient egypt and one of the best recognized figures of antiquity but her image has come in many ways to overshadow the woman herself nefertiti's current world dominion as a cultural and artistic icon presents an interesting contrast with the way in which she was actively written out of history soon after her own death this book explores what we can reconstruct of the life of the queen tracing the way in which she and her image emerged in the wake of the first tentative decipherment of egyptian hieroglyphs during the 1820s 1840s and then took on the world over the next century and beyond all indications are that her final fate was a tragic one but although every effort was made to wipe out nefertiti's memory after her death modern archaeology has rescued the queen pharaoh from obscurity and set her on the road to today's international status

two celebrated egyptologists bring to vivid life the intriguing and controversial reign of king tut's parents akhenaten has been the subject of radically different even contradictory biographies the king has achieved fame as the world's first individual and the first monotheist but others have seen him as an incestuous tyrant who nearly ruined the kingdom he ruled the gold funerary mask of his son tutankhamun and the painted bust of his wife nefertiti are the most recognizable artifacts from all of ancient egypt but who are akhenaten and nefertiti and what can we actually say about rulers who lived more than three thousand years ago november 2022 marks the centennial of the discovery of the tomb of tutankhamun and although king tut is a household name his nine year rule pales in comparison to the revolutionary reign of his parents akhenaten and nefertiti became gods on earth by transforming egyptian solar worship innovating in art and urban design and merging religion and politics in ways never attempted before combining fascinating scholarship detective suspense and adventurous thrills egypt's golden couple is a journey through excavations museums hieroglyphic texts and stunning artifacts from clue to clue renowned egyptologists john and colleen darnell reconstruct an otherwise untold story of the magnificent reign of akhenaten and nefertiti

more than three thousand years ago a sculptor working in the royal city of amarna carved a limestone bust of an egyptian queen the queen was nefertiti consort of the heretic pharaoh akhenaten plastered and painted nefertiti s bust depicted an extraordinarily beautiful woman however akhenaten s reign was drawing to an end and the royal family was soon to be written out of egypt s official history not long after its creation the stone nefertiti was locked in a storeroom and forgotten in 1912 the bust was re discovered and transported to germany initially hidden from the public view the beautiful queen was eventually displayed in berlin museum instantly she became an ancient world celebrity egypt has yielded more than its fair share of artistic masterpieces but no other sculpture has so successfully bridged the gap between the ancient and modern worlds the timeless beauty of the nefertiti bust both attracts us and sparks our imagination but in so doing it obscures our view of the past shifting attention not only from the other members of the amarna court but also from other equally valid representations of nefertiti herself in this book joyce tyldesley explores the creation of a cultural icon from its ancient origins to its modern context its discovery its display and its dual role as a political pawn and artistic inspiration

for over a decade nefertiti wife of the heretic king akhenaten was the most influential woman in the bronze age world a beautiful queen blessed by the sun god adored by her family and worshipped by her people her image and her name were celebrated throughout egypt and her future seemed golden suddenly nefertiti disappeared from the royal family vanishing so completely that it was as if she had never been no record survives to detail her death no monument serves to mourn her passing and to this day her end remains an enigma her body has never been found joyce tyldesley here provides a detailed discussion of the life and times of nefertiti egypt s sun queen set against the background of the ephemeral amarna court

this is the first book written by archaeologist and broadcaster mary chubb about her adventures and experiences on various digs in the near east and east mediterranean this story concerns her time at the site of tell el amarna in egypt the city of akhenaten in 1930 written as a novel but full of historical facts and real life experiences

over more than a century and a quarter of excavations the royal and administrative buildings in the city of amarna have yielded the remains of many hundreds of statues that had been part of akhenaten s visionary plan but fragmentation and dispersal have up until now made the results almost invisible only a relatively small number of the original statues have been widely known even to experts the present publication brings together all these traces of the city s past to reveal the abundance beauty variety and novelty of the statuary and to begin the process of reintegrating it in considerations of the temples and palaces of the city the work is presented in two parts the first volume presents extensive observations about the creation of the statuary comprising chapters dealing with the range of materials and the methods of working them a detailed explication of the novel creation of composite statuary and an overview of the workshop buildings that have been identified so far at amarna in the second volume the excavated fragments themselves most of them previously unpublished are catalogued in a series of chapters devoted to individual royal buildings the original statues are envisioned and analysed for their contexts resulting in new information about these buildings the intentions and concerns behind them and the evolution in those intentions

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
