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in 1963 betty friedan unleashed a storm of controversy with her bestselling book the feminine mystique hundreds of women wrote to her to say that the book had transformed even saved their lives nearly half a century later many women still recall where they were when they first read it in a strange stirring historian stephanie coontz examines the dawn of the 1960s when the sexual revolution had barely begun newspapers advertised for perky attractive gal typists but married women were told to stay home and husbands controlled almost every aspect of family life based on exhaustive research and interviews and challenging both conservative and liberal myths about friedan a strange stirring brilliantly illuminates how a generation of women came to realize that their dissatisfaction with domestic life didn't reflect their personal weakness but rather a social and political injustice

heterosexuality assumed to denote a universal sexual and cultural norm has been largely exempt from critical scrutiny in this boldly original work jonathan ned katz challenges the common notion that the distinction between heterosexuality and homosexuality has been a timeless one building on the history of medical terminology he reveals that as late as 1923 the term heterosexuality referred to a morbid sexual passion and that its current usage emerged to legitimate men and women having sex for pleasure drawing on the works of sigmund freud james baldwin betty friedan

according to judith baer feminist legal scholarship today does not effectively address the harsh realities of women's lives feminists have marginalized themselves she argues by withdrawing from mainstream intellectual discourse in our lives before the law baer thus presents the framework for a new feminist jurisprudence one that would return feminism to relevance by connecting it in fresh and creative ways with liberalism baer starts from the traditional feminist premise that the legal system has a male bias and must do more to help women combat violence and overcome political economic and social disadvantages she argues however that feminist scholarship has over corrected for this bias by emphasizing the ways in which the system fails women feminists have lost sight of how it can be used to promote women's interests and have made it easy for conventional scholars to ignore legitimate feminist concerns in particular feminists have wrongly linked the genuine flaws of conventional legal theory to its basis in liberalism arguing that liberalism focuses too heavily on individual freedom and not enough on individual responsibility in fact baer contends liberalism rests on a presumption of personal responsibility and can be used as a powerful intellectual foundation for holding men and male institutions more accountable for their actions the traditional feminist approach baer writes has led to endless debates about such abstract matters as character differences between men and women and has failed to deal sufficiently with concrete problems with the legal system she thus constructs a new feminist interpretation of three central components of conventional theory equality rights and responsibility through analysis of such pressing legal issues as constitutional interpretation reproductive choice and fetal protection baer concludes by presenting the outline of what she calls feminist post liberalism an approach to jurisprudence that not only values individual freedoms but also recognizes our responsibility for addressing individuals needs however different those may be for men and women powerfully and passionately written our lives before the law will have a major impact on the future course of feminist legal scholarship

forty years ago few women worked married women could not borrow money in their own names schools imposed strict quotas on female applicants and sexual harassment did not exist as a legal concept yet despite the enormous changes for women in america since 1960 and despite a blizzard of books that continue to argue about women's proper place there has not been a serious definitive history of what happened until now sara m evans is one of our foremost historians of women in america her book personal politics is a classic that captured the origins of the modern women's movement its successor born for liberty set the standard for sweeping histories of women in tidal wave evans again sets the standard by drawing on an extraordinary range of interviews archives and published sources to tell the incredible story of the past forty years in women's history encompassing both the so called second wave of feminism's initial explosion in the 1960s and 1970s and the third wave of the 1980s and 1990s she challenges traditional interpretations at every step she shows that the second wave was beset by fragmentation and infighting from the beginning its slogan the personal is political was both a rallying cry and the seed of its self destruction yet the third wave has been surprisingly strong and almost all women today might be thought of as feminists in practice if not in name from national events and from leaders of institutions such as now and emily's list to little known local stories of women who simply wanted more out of their lives only to discover that they were creating a movement tidal wave paints a vast canvas of a society in upheaval from politics to economics to popular culture to marriage and the family today evans argues the women's movement is as alive and vital as ever precisely because it has enjoyed such stunning success though not all women are comfortable with the term feminist the vast majority hold jobs and enjoy previously unimaginable personal freedoms never before in american or world history have women experienced full and equal citizenship and opportunity at last the extraordinary story can be told

during world war ii american women entered the workforce in unprecedented numbers and many of them relied on federally funded child care programs at the end of the war working mothers vigorously protested the termination of child care subsidies in citizen mother worker emilie stoltzfus traces grassroots activism and national and local policy debates concerning public funding of children s day care in the two decades after the end of world war ii using events in cleveland ohio washington d c and the state of california stoltzfus identifies a prevailing belief among postwar policymakers that women could best serve the nation as homemakers although federal funding was briefly extended after the end of the war grassroots campaigns for subsidized day care in cleveland and washington met with only limited success in california however mothers asserted their importance to the state s economy as productive citizens and won a permanent state funded child care program in addition by the 1960s federal child care funding gained new life as an alternative to cash aid for poor single mothers these debates about the public s stake in what many viewed as a private matter help illuminate america s changing social political and fiscal priorities as well as the meaning of female citizenship in the postwar period

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
