of course there are lochs where the fish are not abundant and a beginner may come across as many as an older fisher but we speak of lochs where there are fish to be caught and where each has a fair chance again it is said that the boatman has as much to do with catching trout in a loch as the angler well we dont deny that in an untried loch it is necessary to have the guidance of a good boatman but the same argument holds good as to stream fishing
